


Chili and Soup Cook-Off




LOCAL ORGANISTS MEETING

Supper Club groups for the Winter/Spring 2024 season will be formed soon. Please consider joining a group to chase away the winter blues! If you're not familiar with this program, here is how it works:

- Once sign ups close, all participants will be divided into groups of between 6-8 people (couples will obviously be assigned to the same group). Each group should try to meet once a month February thru May. Each month a different person volunteers to host.
- The suggested plan is that the host (if the dinner is held in a home) provides a simple entrée and the other attendees bring a side dish, salad or dessert for the table. This is intended to be a simple dinner with lots of fellowship and relaxation. Your host may decide to meet at a restaurant for dinner with each individual paying their own way. Some groups meet at restaurants at every gathering.
- Meet on whatever day or time works for those in your group. There are no rules. Do whatever works best for your group.

The groups will be created and contact information will be distributed during the last week in January so that you have time to make plans for your first

dinner (or lunch?) in February.
