

# Preaching Among Friends Online Lay Preaching Workshop

Have you ever considered preaching? Would you like to know more? Maybe God is calling you to share the good news and you wonder what that might look like. The Diocese of Indianapolis is offering a class just for you! It is always nice when we get to hear from others within our own community and abroad. Could that be you?

Preaching Among Friends, a six-week online workshop starting on January 9th for lay preachers. Below are some thoughts of previous participants.

Greg Seamon said "I now read scripture and commentary in a new, and I think better, way. I am now preaching at our church (Trinity Episcopal Church, Lawrenceburg, IN) on a monthly basis. My relationship to my parish and to God has been enhanced."


Laurel Cornell shared four things she liked about Preaching with Friends:

1. The course is organized, so you take it in small steps, with specific

- homework done for every session.
- 2. There are a tremendous number of resources for understanding theology and history and for making it accessible to ordinary people.
- 3. The discussions with other members of the class were excellent. We got to hear each other's work and see how different people approached the same topic.
- 4. One of the best parts was Lisa leading us through how to craft a sermon.

Meghan McConnell shared "The course helped me with really great resources, a wonderful group of people from all over to journey with, and the mentors gave me confidence in myself and my understanding of how to share the Good News. I would highly recommend this course to anyone looking to enrich their ministry or even just faithfully work on the way they are listening to God."

Participants are to purchase their own book prior to class. A class syllabus will be sent out to show what chapters will be read each week.


The class is open to any LGBTQ+ individuals as well as family and friends regardless of denomination.
