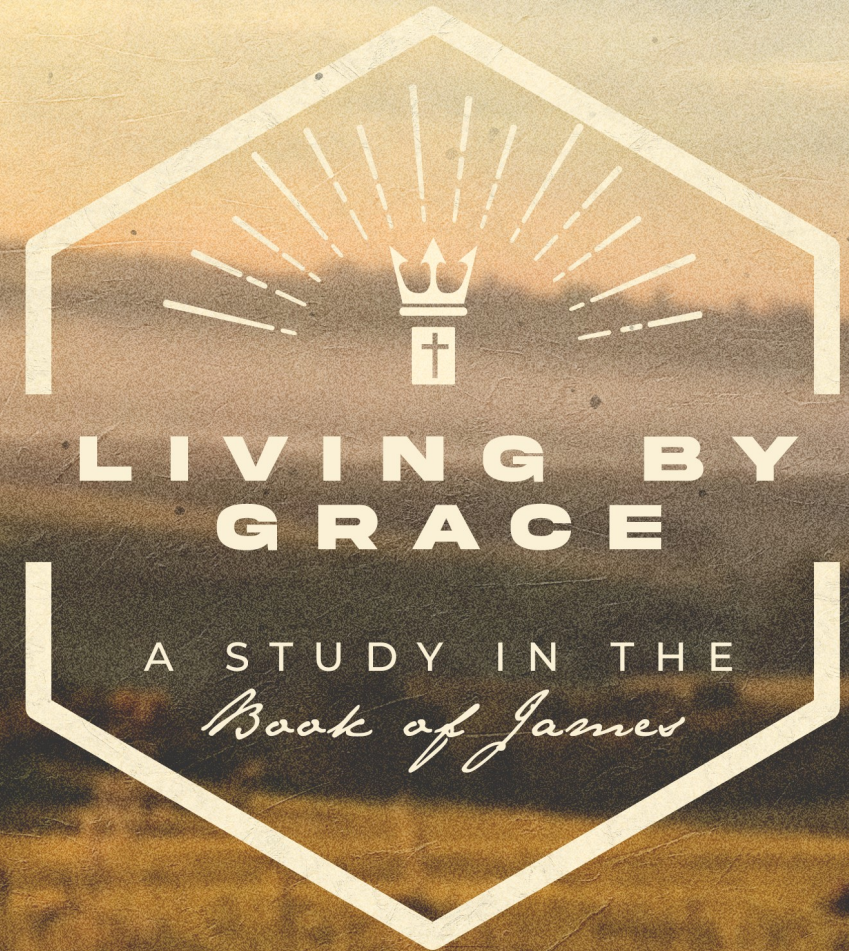

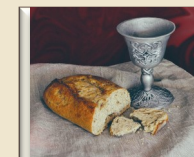

We will be closed on Thursday, July 4th in observance of Independence Day. We will be opened Monday, July 8 from 9:00am-5:00pm.

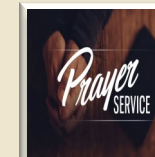
