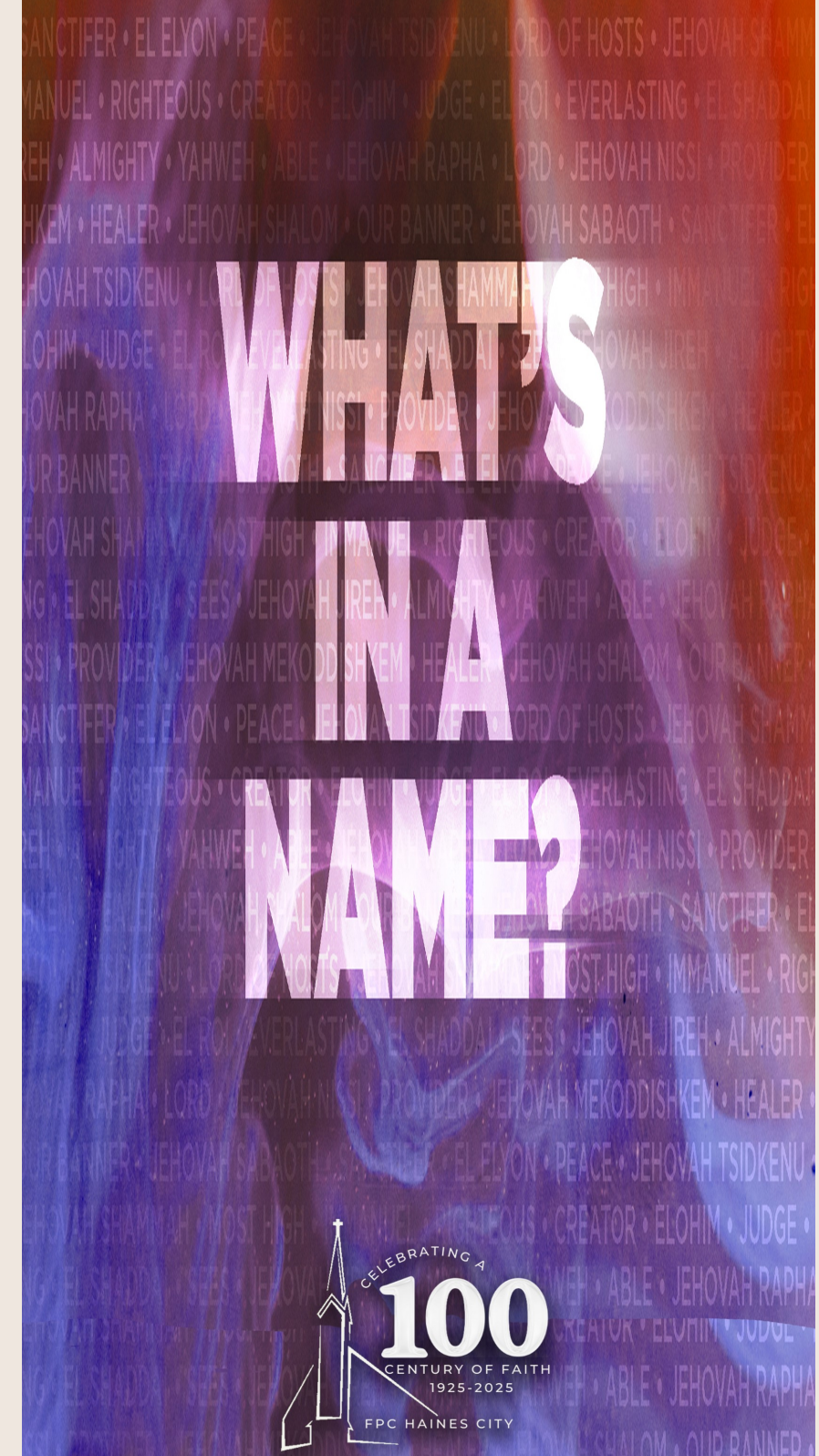
### Lost & Found
