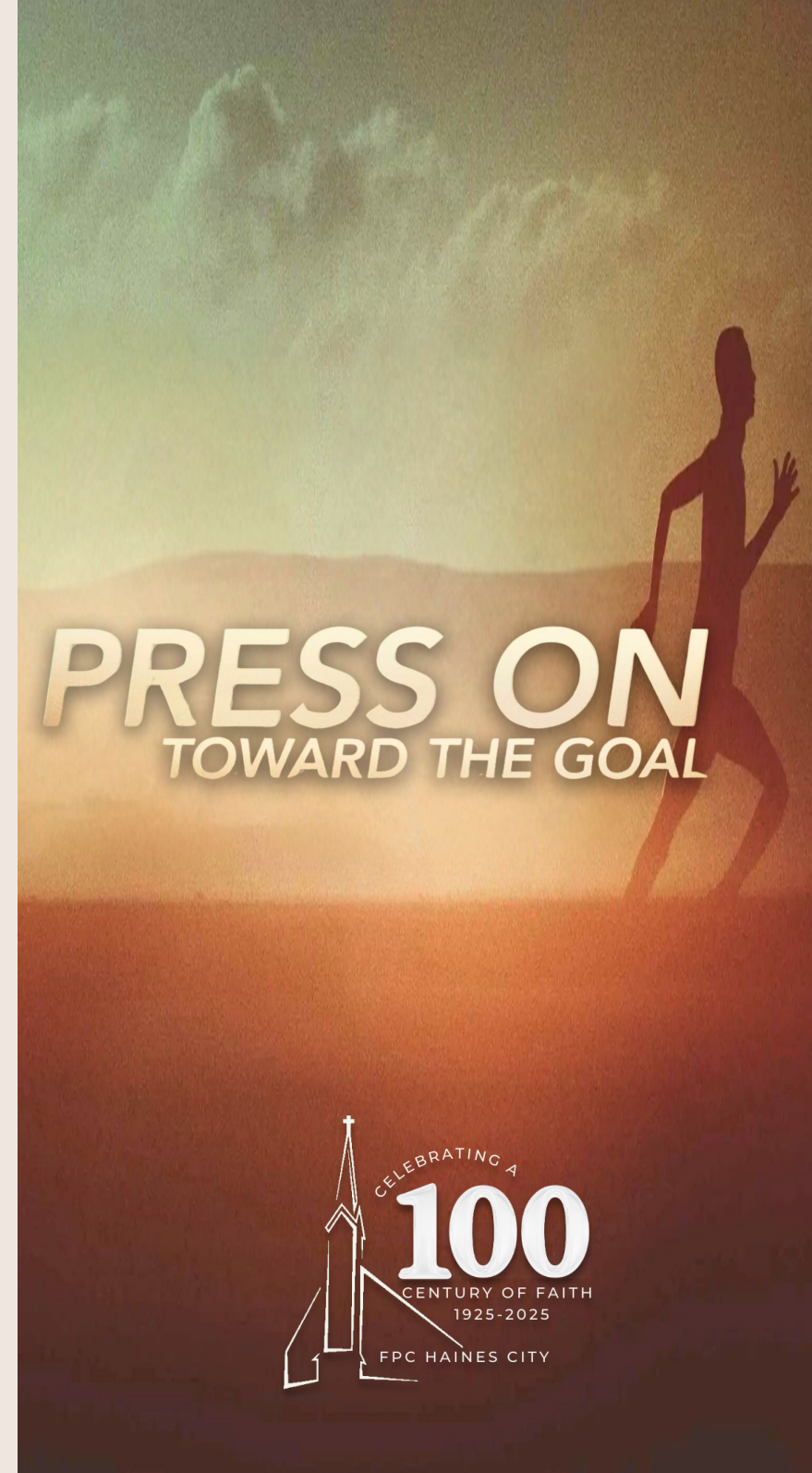
### XYZ Seniors Serve
