I. Name of Scholarship:

Central Nebraska Senior Golf Association Scholarship

II. Specific Provisions:

The CNSGA shall award a monetary scholarship of \$1,000 to male and female high school senior graduates from a CNSGA participating high school.

The scholarship will be awarded based primarily on golf achievement during the applicant's high school years (both academic and non-academic) as indicated in the information provided in an approved application format.

Extra-curricular activities and scholarship shall be considered if two or more candidates are too close in points to declare an outright winner.

The scholarship committee may also elect to award more than two scholarships if they so choose.

Early in the calendar year, the CNSGA scholarship committee shall send to the Counselor or Golf Coach of the high schools within the CNSGA area an announcement with the application forms. Applicants must return the completed forms by the specified entry deadline.

The scholarship chair will screen and score the candidates and then notify the President and Treasurer of the completion of the preliminary review process.

The President will then call a meeting of the Scholarship Committee to make the final decision on the candidates.

The Scholarship Committee shall consist of the President, Treasurer, Scholarship Chairman, and three other board members chosen by the President.

Upon selection of the winners and the amounts to be awarded, the Secretary shall notify the winners and explain the provisions of the scholarship.

In the event a winner cannot accept the scholarship for any reason, the Scholarship Committee shall make a decision whether to award the scholarship to another or return the amount to the CNSGA treasury.

III. Revision of these accords may be made with the approval of the full Board of Directors of the CNSGA at any announced meeting.
