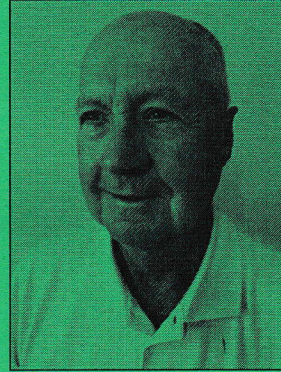


**Dr. Herbert H. Davis and Herbert H. Davis Jr.
Memorial Award**

Floyd "Andy" Anderson is the volunteer executive director of the Central Nebraska Senior Golf Association. Andy has served since 2005, the driving force in growing and developing an active, thriving organization.

CNSGA has expanded its schedule from 23 tournaments a year to between 35 and 38 a year under his direction while doubling participation. He's overseen a transition to electronic communication and encouraged active participation in the group's board of directors.

He assisted the formation of the Northeast Nebraska Senior Golf Association and fostered other cooperation between neighboring associations.

He is a graduate of Lincoln Northeast and UNL who lived for many years in Broken Bow and Johnson Lake before returning to his hometown in 2014.

For years, Herb and John Davis wanted to establish an award in the memory of their father, Dr. Herbert H. Davis, who spent much of his life working to make golf better for everyone in Nebraska. They felt the recipient of such an award should be an individual, or a group of people, who made such an effort behind the scenes without proper public recognition.

Thus, in 1988 the Dr. Herbert H. Davis Memorial Award was born. In 1991, the Nebraska Golf Hall of Fame instituted a Special Recognition Award that had almost identical criteria for nominations. Realizing a great duplication of effort existed, the Davis family and the Hall of Fame board of directors combined the two awards.

In 2003, Herb Davis died while on a golf trip to one of his favorite courses, Sand Hills Golf Club. The Dr. Herbert H. Davis and Herbert H. Davis Jr. Award now is presented annually in their memory.
