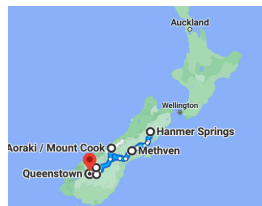
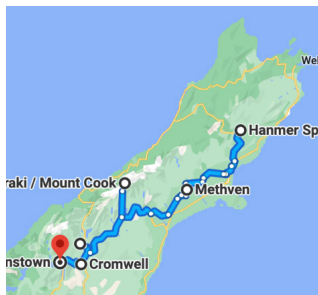

The provinces of Canterbury and Central Otago in the South Island of New Zealand have some great golf courses in spectacular settings. On this tour we have selected a few which we think you will really enjoy playing and we also include some entries to attractions, farm visits and some great local hospitality along the way. After your southern golfing sojourn, fly north for a couple of nights to our largest city, Auckland. A great way to wrap up your tour Downunder!

PROPOSED ITINERARY 2024

Meals: B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

Wednesday, 21 February ARRIVE CHRISTCHURCH

Arrive into Christchurch, the Gateway to the South Island. Transfer to your hotel for some rest and relaxation after your long flight. Spend time discovering the rejuvenated heart of the city with vibrant laneways and hidden gems. Riverside Market is a great spot to check out local produce or perhaps take a stroll through the beautiful Botanic Gardens. This evening a Welcome Dinner to better get to know your travelling companions and chat about your forthcoming tour.

MEALS: - - D OVERNIGHT: Christchurch

Thursday, 22 Feb CHRISTCHURCH

After a peaceful night's sleep and breakfast at the hotel we take an orientation tour of the city this morning. Christchurch is sometimes known as the "Garden City" due to its plethora of public and private gardens. You will also notice the English



architectural influence in some of the older buildings which reflect the early settlement in the 1800s by settlers from that country. The City is going through a new building stage after widespread damage from earthquakes and here is now sense of modernization and vibrancy to the city.

This afternoon head to the nearby **Clearwater Golf Course**. This is a championship course which has been the venue for some of New Zealand's leading tournaments. This Resort course handy to the City and set in a delightful position beside many small lakes and a crystal clear stream which flows through the fairways and give it its name.

After your first game of golf on the tour, return for your drinks and meal and a chance to reflect on your effort!

Friday 23 February

CHRISTCHURCH - PEGASUS - HANMER SPRINGS

A breakfast head north a short distance out of the city to the **Pegasus Golf and Sports Club**. After a welcome and introduction to the tour and course, join some locals for golf and chat - NZ verses USA! As you play the 18 holes you will soon realise that the key to scoring well on this well designed course is by avoiding the numerous water hazards and sand bunkers. After a late snack and game debrief, continue north west to Hanmer Springs for an overnight stay.

Hanmer is an attractive village located in the Waiau River basin and surrounded by striking mountain ranges. After settling into your accommodation perhaps take time for a soak in the thermal hot springs, take a forest walk or climb Conical Hill before dinner.

Saturday 24 February

HANMER SPRINGS - METHVEN

This morning it's time to enjoy the 18 holes on the picturesque,

tree studded **Hanmer Springs** golf course. Then it's time for lunch and social time!

Depart Hanmer south again to the Amuri Basin. Here irrigation has transformed the region and now includes some of the highest producing dairy farms in NZ. Enjoy meeting a local farmer, then head south, hugging the foothills to cross the Waimakariri Gorge and onto the attractive country town of Methven. Dinner is included tonight before a sound sleep taking in the crisp, clean high country air!

MEALS: B, -, D OVERNIGHT: Methven

Sunday 25 February

METHVEN - MOUNT COOK/MACKENZIE COUNTRY

This morning meet the challenges that this renowned 18 holes at the **Terrace Downs Golf Resort** course offers. This course boasts spectacular mountain views and the Rakaia River Gorge. Nearby Mount Hutt is one of New Zealand's best ski fields, with reliable snow from June to October.

Later depart south across the varied farming tapestry of the Canterbury Plains to Geraldine and on over Burkes Pass to the beautiful, and expansive basin of the Mackenzie Country, so named after the historic sheep stealing exploits of the Scottish shepherd Jock Mackenzie! Continue on to Mount Cook where we stay in this beautiful alpine area and enjoy the vistas of New Zealand's highest mountain, Aoraki Mount Cook.

MEALS: B, L, D OVERNIGHT: Mackenzie Country

Monday 26 February MOUNT COOK - WANAKA

After time for a short hike amidst the incredible alpine surrounds, we continue via the stunning aqua blue hydro lakes of Pukaki and Tekapo; the source of the majority of New Zealand's electricity. We'll make a short stop at the salmon farm then on to visit a lake- side high country sheep for an insight into farm life in the mountains and valleys - the domain of thousands of fine woolled merino sheep, beef cattle and farmed red deer. Continue to the beautiful town of Wanaka for a 2 night stay.

MEALS: - - DOVERNIGHT: Wanaka

Tuesday 27 February AROUND WANAKA

This morning we play at the **Wanaka Golf** course, a rolling picturesque course overlooking the town, lake and surrounding mountain ranges. Alternatively you may wish to explore some of the local attractions such as a winery, vintage machinery collection, lavender farm, shops, winery, craft brewery, then enjoy some southern hospitality for a lunch snack in a local cafe.

This evening a stop at the wonderful Cardrona Pub for drinks and a tasty dinner, sampling local produce such as



tasty Cardrona merino lamb.

MEALS: B - -OVERNIGHT: Wanaka

Wednesday 28 February

WANAKA - CROMWELL - QUEENSTOWN

This morning we travel via the lush fruit orchards and vineyards to enjoy golf this morning at the **Cromwell Golf Course**. An inland country course located in, Central Otago, one of the most beautiful regions in NZ. This courses sand dune features are more often associated with our coastal links courses.

After the golf and lunch, possible visits to; a local orchard for a look at cherry, apricot and apple production, one of the renowned wineries in the area - well renowned for their Pinot Noir varietals, or Highland Park, a gem for motor sports enthusiasts set up by a Scottish entrepreneur which made his money selling pet food in Australia.

We then continue via the spectacular Kawarau Gorge and enjoy the delights of historic Arrowtown and Queenstown on the shores of crystal-clear Lake Wakatipu.

MEALS: B, L, D OVERNIGHT: Arrowtown/Queenstown Region

Thursday 29 February

ARROWTOWN/QUEENSTOWN Region

Enjoy golf this morning at the top-rated **Arrowtown Golf Course**. This is a pretty laid- back country course in one of the most spots in NZ. Well-worn weathered rocks line some fairways and if you're lucky they help ricochet your ball back to center fairway....but other outcomes can also happen!

This afternoon there's optional experiences for everyone in this region, from a thrilling jet boat ride to a relaxing lake cruise, a gondola ride to Bob's Peak, shopping or a flight seeing experience to Milford Sound - one of the wonders of the natural world. This evening we take a lake cruise to Walter Peak Station on the old steamer,

Friday 1 March ARROWTOWN/QUEENSTOWN Region

Golf again this morning at another of the beautiful Queenstown courses, such as the **Queenstown Golf course** (or the renowned Jacks Point.)

After golf, transfer to the airport for a flight to Auckland in the North Island of NZ. An orientation tour then settle in to your hotel then dinner MEALS: B - D OVERNIGHT: Auckland

Saturday 2 March QUEENSTOWN -AUCKLAND

Auckland has a sub-tropical climate and you'll notice a distinct change from the temperate vegetation and climate further south. Auckland is renowned its boating and particularly sailing.



The prestigious Americas Cup yachting Regatta has been won by New Zealand and held in this city on more than one occasion.

You will notice that Auckland is a very cosmopolitan city with Polynesian, European and Asian influences. We atke a tour of the city and then this evening a cruise on the Auckland harbour before a Farewell Dinner .
