


STILLPOINT & YOU

PREPARE. PROTECT. PROCEED.



Stillpoint has, in response to the coronavirus, implemented protocols for the professional, routine and real-time cleaning of our center. Please take care to follow those protocols required of presenters, participants and guests. Stillpoint's full Prepare. Protect. Proceed. protocol and information on the center hours are posted at stillpointcsd.org and the center.

1 STAY HOME IF SICK

If you or a family member is exhibiting signs of illness consistent with COVID-19 symptoms or have come in contact with someone who has the virus, please do not visit the center. Please call 702.243.4040 if you have questions, or visit stillpointcsd.org for information and a listing of virtual programs you can participate in from home.



2 CLEAN HANDS

Clean your hands thoroughly before coming to Stillpoint, upon entering the center, and again if you touch your face. Please note: if you choose to wear gloves, they must be new gloves that have not been worn when visiting other offices, stores or homes.



3 WEAR A MASK

Wear a mask for your protection and the protection of others as COVID-19 symptoms may not be immediately apparent. NOTE: If you have temporarily removed a mask to sip a beverage, remember that coughs or sneezes should be covered by an elbow or shirt collar rather than your hand.



4 BRING YOUR OWN BEVERAGE

Bring your own water, pre-made coffee or tea, and pre-packaged snack (should you need one). These Stillpoint hospitality services are currently unavailable for safety.

5 CALL OR RING DOORBELL

Upon arriving at Stillpoint, call 702.243.4040 or ring the doorbell for entry. Stillpoint will limit gathering sizes based on State of Nevada guidelines.



6 MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE

Maintain social distance from other Stillpoint guests and staff members in meeting spaces, hallways and reception desk. Also, practice non-contact greetings with the assumption that others are opting not to shake hands or hug. Note: Your prayer group or program maybe moved to a different room based on current gathering size and spacing recommendations.



7 ALLOW A FEW EXTRA MINUTES

Allow for additional time for normal practices, particularly transactions at the reception guest. Note: In-person donations and payments will be accepted. Online payment and donation tools are also accessible at stillpointcsd.org.



8 ASSIST IN WAYS THAT WORK

Where and when possible, you are invited to assist with Stillpoint's real-time cleaning processes by wiping down your chair or table space as part of a shared effort to heighten the ongoing cleanliness of the center.



Stillpoint's professional, routine and real-time cleaning protocols include having cleaning supplies readily available. You are also encouraged to carry personal hand sanitizer and hand wipes.
