# Pandemic-Related Disaster Recovery

Louisiana is no stranger to devastating events throughout the state. Due to this, Louisiana is forced to be resilient through hurricanes, tornadoes, and floods. The state's economy has bounced back from several natural disasters, with Hurricane Katrina being the most memorable. This past year though, the state of Louisiana, along with the rest of the country, faced a challenge never-before seen. During 2020 and 2021, every person in America was affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. It has permanently closed nearly 100,000 businesses' doors and crippled economies across the United States. In Northwest Louisiana in particular, COVID-19 crippled some of the most prominent industries in the area. Casinos, hotels, restaurants, and other tourism draws were hurt by the pandemic, along with oil and gas and manufacturing industries. In this state, most communities have natural disaster recovery plans. What is needed in the region is an economic resilience plan focused on preventing, preparing for, and responding to pandemics. Resilience is measured by how well a region handles different stressors like natural disasters or pandemics. The communities in Northwest Louisiana must band together to create more resilient economies, communities, and local governments.

No region has handled the COVID-19 pandemic perfectly. Fortunately, there are steps that can be taken to better prepare our region for when another health crisis arises. We must address the infrastructure pitfalls in our communities. In terms of economic development, there are several issues that should be addressed. Minimizing the impact that a pandemic has on our economy and employment rate is one of the most important goals in economic planning. Not only local government bodies, but also businesses must have plans to handle pandemics when they arise. The following pages contain tips and suggestions from The Coordinating & Development Corporation on how businesses can handle a pandemic. Keep in mind, this is generalized and not tailored for just COVID-19.



# Planning for Pandemics



Before any response plan can be formed, a region needs to be prepared for a shock. Resilience is all about moving forward from a setback quickly and with minimal negative impact. Resiliency is built through advanced preparation and planning at different levels of the community. In Northwest Louisiana, there are several areas that should be addressed to increase resiliency. In addition to conventional emergency planning, pandemic preparedness should be addressed through different improvements throughout the region.

## Community Development

Now more than ever, it is evident that community development projects are paramount. Infrastructure improvement has become a more glaring need over the past two years, and our infrastructure's shortcomings became clear. With the stay-at-home order, problems with water, sewer, cell connectivity, and broadband were amplified. The Louisiana Community Development Block Grant (LCDBG) and Capital Outlay programs both provide funding opportunities for street, water, and sewer projects. These types of projects that deal with basic public infrastructure are needed in many parts of the region. To reduce the impact of pandemics, reducing risks of infrastructure-related emergencies is important. When there is not any water left to buy at the store, the drinking water of a municipality needs to be up to health standards. When people are stuck in their homes, waste management needs to work as it should.

## Economic Development

Local economies are extremely important to a region's resilience. A sign of a thriving economy is diversity, which is built through available resources, a strong workforce, and a strong entrepreneurial presence. From healthcare to entertainment to oil and gas, the region has a strong and diverse economy when everything is open. During the COVID-19 pandemic, several factors contributed to a smaller workforce, business closures, and hurting industries. As a region, it is important to build up our economic resilience through planning for health events.

A prepared community is the backbone of a resilient economy which is much less likely to derail from a large shock. Basic public infrastructure needs can be addressed in economic development as well as community development. Better infrastructure tends to draw better and more business(es). The Delta Regional Authority (DRA) is a great funding outlet for economic development in the region. Though their reach excludes Bossier, Caddo, and Sabine Parishes, the DRA funds projects that can create jobs or improve communities for business creation in a large portion of our region. The Economic Development Administration (EDA) also has several funding opportunities for our region that include disaster recovery, resilience building, creating equity for undeserved populations, etc.

## Workforce Development

During the COVID-19 outbreak, workers left jobs because of fear of unsafe conditions, workers were laid off due to temporary closures, and workers were forced into unemployment because of stay-at-home orders. The region needs to address the safety concerns of employees to keep employment numbers as strong as possible. Having a large workforce is paramount to a strong economy. The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) is a workforce program that prepares participants for entry or re-entry into the workforce through training and education, creating a more knowledgeable and skilled workforce.

## Broadband

Access to broadband has become a notable issue in rural parts of the region. During a pandemic, stay-at-home orders can force schools to shift to online learning. During the COVID-19 pandemic, students without broadband access were either given a hotspot, which lacked adequate download speeds, or were forced to use the wireless Internet at public locations like libraries and schools. The same problem was faced by people who had to work from home. Additionally, many healthcare providers encourage patients to use telehealth appointments rather than risk exposure at in-person appointments during a pandemic. Broadband is also an important issue when it comes to economic development. Several industries in rural areas could be improved and become more competitive with access to reliable broadband. There are established and emerging initiatives through federal and state dollars to improve the availability and speed of broadband in the region.



# Preventing & Responding to Pandemics

After an initial crisis begins, a response plan must go into action. This is true for every level of organization, from individuals to governments. There is a great difference in a pandemic response plan and natural disaster response plan. They can both be categorized as emergencies, but there are factors that should be considered when dealing with a pandemic. As the whole country has learned recently, pandemics do not operate on limited time such as hurricanes, tornadoes, etc. No one can say for a fact when everything will “return to normal.” Many unknown problems arise during pandemics such as virus mutation, spikes, and different individual reactions.

## Identifying the Factors of a Pandemic

A few important factors must be considered when responding to a health-related disaster. The contagion of the disease is something that must be taken into close consideration. “Contagion” refers to how contagious the disease is and how long an individual is contagious. The mode of transmission is also something that should factor into decision-making. This refers to how the bacterium or virus travels from person to person. A virus or bacterium can travel through airborne particles, saliva particles, or physical contact between individuals. The mortality rate should also be considered during an outbreak. The mortality rate can be more forgiving or severe in different populations.

## Understanding Mandates

During COVID-19, many states and municipalities imposed mask mandates. It is important for businesses as well as municipality leadership to understand the governor’s mandates. For much of 2020, there was a governor-imposed mask mandate as well as six feet apart rules in Louisiana. If those are the stipulations for staying open and keeping the economy working, it is important that the rules are understood and followed.

## Business Closures

There was a time in 2020 when only essential businesses could remain open because during a pandemic public health is the top priority. However, it is paramount for businesses to remain operational if they can. As of September 2020, according to Yelp’s data, 60% of businesses that closed their doors temporarily due to COVID-19, never reopened. Even at limited capacity, it will benefit a business in the long run to stay open. When Louisiana opened businesses back up, they were opened in phases. Community leaders must understand what each opening phase entails.

## Vaccinations

Vaccines may roll out immediately or may be delayed. This depends on whether a vaccine already exists or if a new vaccine must be developed, tested, and approved. Each state will have a different roll-out plan, but each community needs the proper infrastructure in place to receive, store, distribute, and deliver the vaccine. During COVID-19, each state decided who could be vaccinated first (older populations/sick individuals). This can change based on the nature of the vaccines and who the disease affects more severely.

## Pandemic’s End

The end of a pandemic is reached when the virus or bacterium is no longer a threat to spread rapidly even when the population is exposed. This is considered herd immunity. Per Harvard Health, “herd immunity is usually achieved through vaccination, but it can also occur through natural infection.”

# Open Safely

Companies should have the proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) that adheres to the protocols for all workers. Companies do have a choice whether they enforce PPE rules on customers. If required, social distancing should be enforced. Many businesses mark the floors with tape to indicate a safe distance between customers. Below are a few pages from The Coordinating & Development Corporation's Worksafe Gameplan. Although this is Coronavirus-specific, it can be used as a guide for businesses returning to work during a pandemic.

### Protect the Company's General Workforce Through:

1. Personal hygiene.
2. Social distancing.
3. Frequently cleaning common surfaces.

## PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

### Face Masks

Face masks are an important part of employee protection as well as personal hygiene, social distancing, and frequent disinfection efforts. Face masks are a risk mitigation strategy where social distancing cannot be consistently practiced and can reduce COVID-19 transmission risk from sick yet asymptomatic employees overall. Face masks continue to be in critical shortage globally, so their reuse provides significant benefit, and for many may be the difference between having a mask or none at all. The cost of providing new masks daily may create financial hardships for employers who are small or who work on very tight margins, and as in the above point, reuse may mean the difference between having a mask or none at all.

- Face masks are required PPE for all personnel when entering or exiting the building and while walking around the centers.
- Personal face masks may be used by employees in lieu of a company supplied mask.
- Homemade face masks are permitted on company premises or in company transportation.
- Homemade face masks must cover the nose and mouth completely.
- Employees will be allowed to remove masks when they are in/seated at their office/desk.

## Gloves

Our top priority is always protecting people. Based on the Center for Disease Control's findings, the company will not require or recommend that our employees wear gloves.

**Note: Gloves put employees at higher risk of exposure and are not recommended for general protective use for the following reasons: (Sited: cdc.gov)**

- The COVID-19 virus does not harm your hands, so gloves provide no protection. However, touching your face with contaminated hands, whether gloved or not, poses a significant risk of infection.
- Gloves often create a false sense of security for the individuals wearing them. People are more likely to touch contaminated surfaces because they feel the gloves protect them from the virus when, in reality, they do not.
- When wearing gloves, people are less inclined to wash their hands. This is counterproductive and puts others at higher risk. We want people to wash their hands because it is the number-one defense against any virus.
- Proper removal of gloves takes training. If contaminated gloves are not removed properly, our employees are exposed to greater risk.

## GENERAL DISINFECTION MEASURES

Employees should sanitize and disinfect all of their areas while also always cleaning behind themselves in the following areas:

- Workstations
- Restrooms
- Kitchen/Breakroom
- Common areas
- Resource rooms

### Suggested Disinfection Practices

1	Common Surfaces/Areas	common surfaces	Disinfectant spray/wipes	spray or wipe	minimum at the end of each day
2	Offices, desks and conference rooms	table and chair surfaces	Disinfectant spray/wipes	spray or wipe	minimum at the end of each day and/or meeting
3	General objects that are used or touched often	doors, windows, handles, faucets, sinks and bathrooms	Disinfectant spray/wipes	spray or wipe	minimum at the end of each day
4	Breakrooms/ Kitchens	table and chair surfaces, dispensers, etc.	Disinfectant spray/wipes	spray or wipe	after all breaks/meals
5	Vending machines	interface surfaces (pay, selection and vending surfaces)	Disinfectant spray/wipes	spray or wipe	minimum at the end of each day
6	Floors and walls	all general floors and walls on site	Disinfectant/bleach solution	mop	periodically, when deemed necessary

- The cleaning steps outlined above should be taken routinely based on the frequency mentioned to protect employees and disinfect workplace surfaces, chairs, tables, etc.
- Along with these workplace disinfection activities, proper personal sanitary practices, including washing hands after bathroom use, are also necessary.

## DEEP-CLEANING AND DISINFECTION PROTOCOL

### About

The General Disinfection Measures Protocol should be followed regularly whereas the Deep-Cleaning and Disinfection Protocol is triggered when an active employee or visitor is identified as positive for COVID-19 based on testing.

### Coronavirus (COVID-19) Deep-Cleaning and Disinfection

COVID-19 deep-cleaning is triggered when an active employee is identified as being COVID-19 positive based on testing. Businesses may opt to have a deep cleaning performed for presumed cases at their discretion.

Deep-cleaning should be performed as soon as possible after the confirmation of a positive test. If a delay greater than a day is encountered, the businesses should take steps to disinfect until deep-cleaning can occur.

## SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOL

Social distancing is a simple yet very effective mechanism to prevent potential infection.

In practice, this means:

- Staying 6 feet away from others as a normal practice.
- Eliminating contact (handshakes or embracing) with visitors, friends, or others.
- Avoiding touching surfaces touched by others, to the extent feasible.
- Avoiding anyone who is coughing, sneezing, or appears to be sick.

Social distancing is intended to provide a safe environment that reduces the risk of potential person-to-person infection.

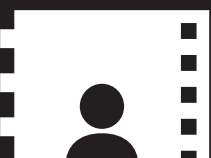
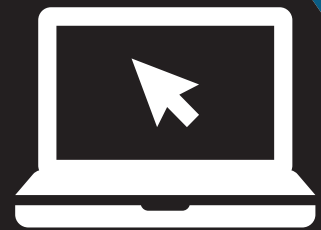
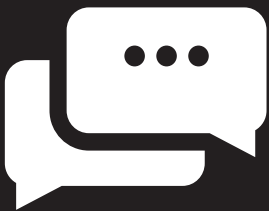
### Guidelines:

- Maintain a social distance of 6 feet throughout the workplace.
- When a minimum distance cannot be maintained due to workplace design, PPE should be worn.
- Workers are strongly encouraged to disinfect their own work space at the end of each day.
- Employees should be reminded to avoid touching their faces and should wash their hands thoroughly with soap and water several times during the work hours to reduce risk and potential person-to-person infections.
