Founding faculty will be required to teach across a breadth of disciplines, as well as within an interdisciplinary team; we encourage candidates with expertise in multiple areas of the physical and life sciences, as well as mathematics.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of five years of teaching experience
- Waldorf teacher training and/or Waldorf teaching experience
- Bachelor's degree in math, science, education or related field; advanced degree preferred.
