# RSVP Advisol




We want to know what type of volunteers each Station needs. We want to design a plan that will benefit each site by assessing the specific volunteer training requirements and opportunities at










# #911/HIGHFIVE4HEROES - EVENTS







## Rapid HIV Screening





- · No needles required

## FINGER STICK:

Finger Stick Screening
Tests for HIV antibodies/antigens
A tiny sample of blood from finger
detects antibodies faster & more
accurately than an oral screening.
-Also used to test for Hepatitis C

### RESULTS:

Results for both an HIV and Hepatitis C test can be received with a single prick of the finger.
