Five Star: Awarded to an organization demonstrating leadership and best practices in the development and application of proven distance learning technologies and/or video production supporting distance learning in the Federal Government.

Innovation: Awarded to an organization demonstrating excellence in the *innovative* use of technology and/or video-based content in the development and delivery of distance learning supporting the Federal Government.

<u>Individual</u>

Pioneer: Awarded to an individual who demonstrates initiative and leadership in the development and implementation of distance learning in the Federal Government.

Hall of Fame: Awarded to an individual who has, over several years, made significant contributions in promoting and developing distance learning in the Federal Government
