I-95/SR 84 Construction

Construction on the I-95 and SR-84 Interchange

is well underway. I thought it would be nice to get a progress update on the project. Shelby Rodriguez, Transportation Planner, and the FDOT Project Team will be joining us for our next meeting to discuss construction, and provide an updated timeline for completion. Speeding On 29th Street

We recently requested a traffic calming evaluation on SW 29th St. After conducting a site visit and reviewing the request with the city's engineer, it was recommended that SW 29th St between SW 15th Ave and SW 9th Ave receive refreshed pavement markings. Currently, the street has extremely faded pavement markings which may give motorists the illusion of a wide, straight road that can encourage speeding. Pavement markings will help delineate the travel lane and encourage safe driving behavior.

A faded Stop Sign on SW 29th St and SW 9th Ave was also observed, and it was requested to the County to be replaced. We will continue to work with the city to identify long-term solutions to the speeding issues in our neighborhood. A big "thank you" to the City for their prompt action on this street.

Stormwater Improvement Update

The Commission awarded the Edgewood stormwater improvement project to David Mancini & Sons, Inc. at the October 5th meeting. The next step is to execute the construction agreement which can take up to two months. The City is hopeful that construction will commence in January of 2022.



The Contractor is planning to be present at one of our association meetings in the near future to set expectations with our neighborhood. Following the execution of the agreement, I will coordinate a date and let everyone know. It's important that we are all informed of this long-awaited project and I encourage residents to participate.
