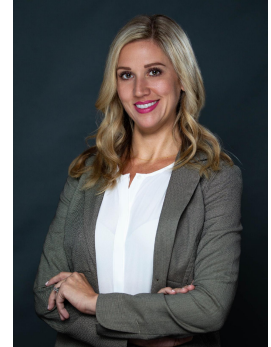




Hello Edgewood Neighbor!

- **Neighborhood Action Team Presence.** Have you noticed an increase in police presence and a decrease in crime? This is due to our wonderful Neighborhood Action Team returning to our neighborhood for patrols, keeping us safe at home.
- **Virtual Learning "POD" at the our very own Clubhouse** With the requirement of virtual learning, Edgewood has responded. We have four first graders facilitating their online learning at the Clubhouse, allowing parents to continue to work and provide for their families.
- **Neighborhood Cleanup.** Our neighborhood is looking great! Code Enforcement has made increased efforts to inspect our neighborhood on a weekly basis, cleaning up and issuing citations for violations.
- **Census Material Distribution.** We came together as a neighborhood and went door-to-door distributing important information on Census completion.
- **Stormwater Improvements.** Stormwater draining has been a major issue in the community for years. Did you know we are first on the list for drainage improvements? This project is set to begin February 2021!
- **Virtual Monthly Meetings.** We are now having our monthly meetings via Zoom. Our meetings are held on the first Wednesday of every month, beginning at 6:45pm. We socialize, discuss important issues and happenings around the neighborhood and city, have guest speakers, and close with our police report.
