The holiday season has arrived. Although this one may be somewhat different with the added travel restrictions and safety recommendations, I for one am looking forward to a relaxed (non-travel!) holiday at home with my immediate loved ones. I have even dusted off a few of my favorite holiday recipes since I will be cooking at home, and wanted to share my favorite with you!

Baked Brie

Ingredients: 1 pastry puff sheet, 1 wheel of brie, 1 egg, your favorite jam and crushed pecans or almonds (optional).

Pre-heat oven to 350 degrees. Roll-out pastry sheet. Cut a thin layer off the top of the brie, then place on pastry sheet, cut side up. Add a few spoons of jam (I use raspberry) and top with crushed pecans. Fold the pastry sheet over the brie,

sealing any holes. Place on a lined baking sheet. Mix one egg with a tablespoon of water for an egg wash, and brush over the pastry sheet. Bake for 30 minutes or until golden brown. Brie will be very hot, so let cool for 10 minutes and serve alone, with bread, crackers, or apple slices.

This dish never lasts more than 10 minutes in my home. Enjoy!


