Workers that have been terminated, laid off, had a reduction of hours or are self employed and unable to work due to COVID-19 are eligible for up to \$800 in supportive services.

Supportive services award can be used for

- Mortgage or Rental Assistance
- Utility Assistance
(Electricity, Natural Gas, Water/Sewer/Garbage Service, etc.)
- Telework Equipment
(Computer/Laptop, Internet Service, etc.)
