## Is Bridge the Gap working?

Last month, a 36-year-old man arrived at the clinic barely able to walk even while using a walker, complaining of severe back pain for more than six months. Upon the doctor's examination, it was clear that the patient needed a neurosurgical consultation immediately, but without a current MRI, the neurosurgical team would not see him. Utilizing "Bridge the Gap" funds, an urgent MRI was performed which confirmed the need for neurosurgical intervention. Based on the diagnostic findings, complete paralysis would have been imminent if left untreated.
