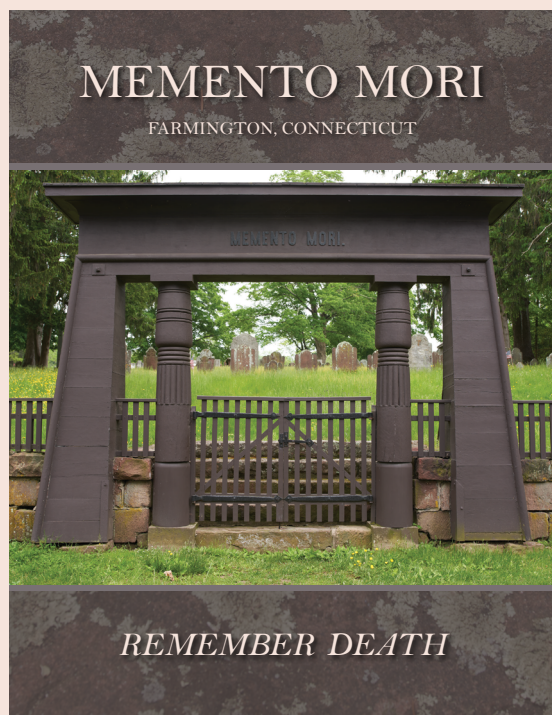


Stanley-Whitman House is delighted to announce the publication of two books:



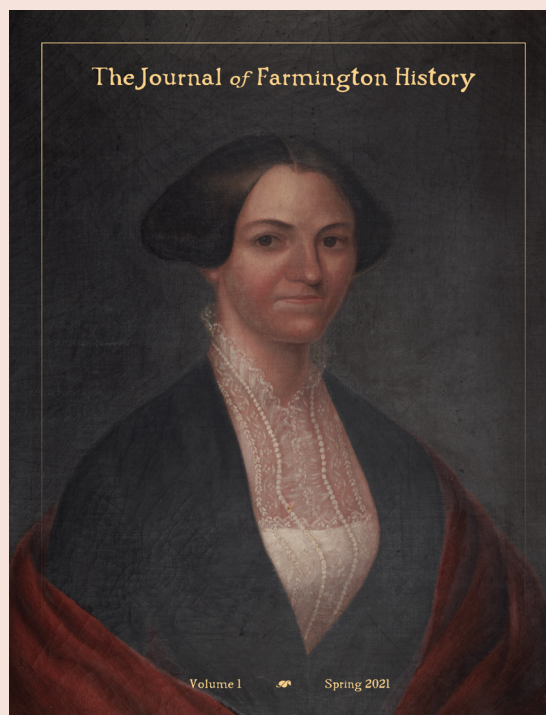
