In our last worksheet, we learned that the Holy Spirit is God, and God is a Trinity, Three-In-One. So, the Holy Spirit is different than God the Father, and different than God the Son, but the same in many ways, because He is God, as they are. We also learned that the Holy Spirit convicts us of the sin in our lives and of our need for God's forgiveness. He also makes us new people ("born again") when we put our trust in God, and helps us to become more and more like Jesus. In this worksheet, we'll learn even more about the Holy Spirit.

Jesus came from heaven to earth on that very first Christmas. He lived on this earth for about 33 years. Then He died on the cross (on Good Friday), came back to life (on Easter Sunday), and then returned to heaven weeks later. So, Jesus is no longer physically with His followers. When He was still on earth, His followers were worried when they heard that Jesus would soon



go back to heaven. In that moment, Jesus comforted them by saying, "No. I will not abandon you as orphans (kids without parents). I will come to you" (John 14:18). But, HOW would Jesus come to His followers?

John 14:26 – "But the Father will send "the Friend" in My name to help you. "The Friend" is the Holy Spirit. He will teach you all things. He will remind you of everything I have said to you."

This "Friend" that God the Father would send to His people after Jesus left them is the Holy Spirit. Let's consider what the verse above says:

- The Holy Spirit is our "Friend": He is close to us and, like a friend, "walks" with us in life. He's always there for us, comforting us when we hurt, encouraging us when we're sad, giving us courage when we're afraid.
- The Holy Spirit is with us to "help" us: How does He help us? By "teaching" us "all things," things that we need to know to live life God's way. And He reminds us of God's truth, things that we read in the Bible, verses that we memorize.
