
## MEMORIZE

Psalm 139:13-14 – "For You created my inmost being. You knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Your works are wonderful, I know that full well."

Did you know that no two snowflakes are the same? Each one is unique. Each one is beautiful. People are like snowflakes, in this way. Unique and beautiful, each one. And, not only are they unique and beautiful after they are born, they are like this even before they are born. That's why unborn babies need to be treated with care. They are part of God's special creation.

Years ago, a movie was made called "Horton Hears a Who." You might have seen this movie. In this movie, Horton the elephant says something very wise. He says...



Psalm 139 says the same thing: A person's a person no matter how small. A baby in the womb is a person, just like you.

## MEMORIZE

Psalm 139:17-18 – "God, Your thoughts about me are priceless. No one can possibly add them all up. If I could count them, they would be more than the grains of sand."

Isn't it amazing that God thinks about you? There are billions of people alive on earth, and He takes time to think about you! The world around you wants you to think that God does not exist or, if He does, that He doesn't care about you. The Bible says different. God cares about you, more than you can imagine.

## **MEMORIZE**

Psalm 139:23-24 - "Search me, O God, and know my heart. Test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends You, and lead me along the path of everlasting life."

Not only does God care about you, but He wants to be your friend. But friendship with God happens only when you ask Him to forgive your sins, when you put your trust no longer in anyone or anything else other than Him for your salvation, and for life.

The above verses are a great prayer to pray to God. Ask Him, every day, to show you how you have sinned, how you have disobeyed Him. And, when He shows you, ask Him to forgive you. This not only begins a friendship with God, but it keeps us close to Him, good friends with Him.

Walking on God's path means that we live life His way, shown



most clearly to us in the Bible, His message to us. The Bible is like a map, showing us God's path, the path we need to walk on to please Him and to thrive in life.
