Name







Did you know that God has a name? We don't use His name very much. We usually call Him "God" or "the Lord," which is fine. But, God has a name. It's "Yahweh" (yah-way) or "Jehovah" (juh-ho-vuh). In the Bible, when you see the word "LORD" in all capital letters, that is the personal name for God, "Yahweh." Someday, we'll talk more about this name,

"Yahweh." But for now, let's discover some more names for God. He has many other names, and each of these names help us to know Him better.



Memorize

Psalm 9:10a – "Those who know Your (God's) name trust in You."

"a" means the first part of the verse



The verse above says that knowing God's names doesn't just help us to know Him better, but it helps us to trust Him more, too. Another word for trust is the word "faith." Knowing God's names makes our faith stronger.

ELOHIM: GOD, AMAZING CREATOR

The first name for God we find in the Bible is the name "Elohim" (el-o-heem). It's in the first verse of the Bible.

MEMORIZE

Genesis 1:1 – "In the beginning, God (Elohim) created the heavens and the earth."

Often, we are told that the universe, the world, the plants and animals, people – everything just happened. But the Bible says

different. The Bible says that God created everything that we can see and can't see ... from nothing! Isn't that amazing! God is like an artist, painting an amazing painting. God is like an engineer, designing and building an incredible machine.

Don't forget, as we learned about in "God & Me," God made us – people – in His image. Though we are not God and never will be God, in some wonderful way we are like Him. That means that you and everyone are special. God loves you!

EL ROI: GOD WHO SEES ME

Some people think that God exists, but they don't think that He sees them or cares about them. They talk about Him like He made a machine, started it, and then walked away, not thinking about it ever again. But, that's not who God is. The Bible says that God sees us, that He cares about us and our needs.

In the Bible, in Genesis 16, a lady named Hagar (hey-gar) ran



away from a tough problem that she had. She felt all alone. In this moment, God (through one of His angels) tells her that He sees her, that He cares about her, that He will help her. So, in this moment, Hagar gives God a name: El Roi (el raw-ee), meaning "the God who sees me."

MEMORIZE

Psalm 121:1-3 – "I look up to the mountains. Does my help come from there? My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth. He will not let you stumble. The One who watches over you will not slumber."
