Last time you read *The Picture Bible*, you read up to page 401. We saw God give courage to Elijah the prophet to stand up for God and His truth. Elijah’s time on earth is almost done...

Read pages 402-420

- God instructs Elijah to call to be Israel’s next prophet. He witnesses Elijah being taken up to heaven in a of fire.
- Evil Queen Jezebel has falsely accused of cursing God and the king. Because of this, he was stoned to death. God punishes King Ahab for this sin, and will soon punish Queen Jezebel, too.
- Elisha instructs Naaman, sick with leprosy, to go to the Jordan River and bathe times. Naaman is healed!

Read pages 421-439

- Dothan, the city Elisha is staying in, is surrounded by Syrian soldiers. Elisha prays that his servant would see what he sees, the of heaven surrounding the city, protecting God’s people.
- Once again, God miraculously saves His people. This time, it’s the city of The Syria army that surrounded it ran away in fear as they heard a great army, God’s army, coming to defeat them.
- is anointed as the next king of Israel. He is instructed by God’s prophet to remove Queen Jezebel and her son, King Jehoram, from the throne. God’s judgment on this family is finally completed.

Read pages 440-459

- In the southern kingdom of Judah, Athaliah, Ahab and Jezebel’s evil daughter is the Queen. She has all the royal family killed so no one will challenge her for the throne. Thankfully, a young prince named is kept safe, and 6 years later is crowned king.
- Five generations after Joash, Hezekiah becomes king. During his reign, the Assyrian army surrounded the city of Hezekiah trusted God to save his city and kingdom, and God miraculously defeated the Assyrian army.

Read pages 460-474

- After centuries of a lack of faithfulness to God, God disciplines His people by allowing the Empire to destroy Jerusalem, and take many captives back to their country.
- After 70 years in captivity, far from Israel, God allows His people to return to their homeland and rebuild it. Nearly a century after the first group returns, arrives in Jerusalem to lead the rebuilding of its walls.

Read pages 475-490

- Queen risks her life, walking uninvited into the throne room of the king to eventually ask him to save her people, the Jews. God protects her and the Jews, His people.
