Essay

The 2024 Essay Question is "What is your greatest Alaskan Adventure?" The essay should be 1-2 pages typed, double spaced, New Times Roman font size 12. (A template is shown below) This will be the essay that you are telling on stage, in a costume.

Letter of Community Support (One is REQUIRED, but up to two letters may be submitted.)

This is a letter of recommendation for you. It may come from a teacher in school, extracurricular coach or mentor, an employer or supervisor, or someone who oversights your volunteer work. This person must be an adult in your life, who knows you personally or professionally, and is not related to you. They may submit the letters directly to the pageant director or the contestant may submit them with their application packet.

Biography and Headshot

The headshot should be of approximately your shoulders and up. The focus should be on your face and it should have good lighting. This is the first time the judges will see what you look like. NO SELFIES! Background should be plain and your clothing should represent you.

The biography is all about you and should be 4-5 sentences all about you. This will be used to create our script for the pageant and give the judges some quick information about you.

Private Panel Style Interview

The interview is your first time meeting the judges. You will be in a waiting room at the Chugiak Eagle River Chamber of Commerce and will be brought into the room with judges. You will introduce yourself and your timer will start. The interview is 10 minutes long, with 30 seconds for closing comments. It is panel style, meaning the judges will rotate asking questions. There are two "standard" questions all contestants will be asked, otherwise the questions are based on your essay, resume, letter of community support, and related to Alaskan high school students. Attire is professional or fashion forward professional. For girls, jumpsuits, dresses, pantsuits, and skirts are all appropriate. For boys, slacks and a button up shirt or a suit are appropriate. Think of this as a job interview, and dress accordingly.

On Stage Opening Number

The entire group will enter the stage and introduce themselves. This is short, but shows the audience your personality. For Attire girls in a black dress and for boys, black shirt and pants.

On State Essay Presentation with Costume

You come onto stage alone to share your essay story wearing a costume that fits your story. This is approximately 2-3 minutes long. After 5 minutes, you will be cut off. Your costume should show effort and reflect your story and match the theme.

On Stage Evening Attire Walk

You will be announced by the MC and will walk onto stage and pose. You will then walk in a pattern that will be taught to you. Then you will begin into On Stage Questions. For this category, you will be wearing "Evening Attire". This can be a prom dress, pageant dress, formal gown: whatever you feel best in. Must be floor length. For boys, a suit with a jacket and tie or tux are both appropriate.

One Stage Questions

This happens during your On Stage Evening Attire Walk. After you have done your walking pattern, you will stand next to our MC. You will be asked 2 questions total. The first questions will come directly from the judges based on your private interview and you will answer it. The second one will be drawn from a bowl of questions, and you will answer that one. The MC will hand you the microphone each time to speak. There is no required length of speaking, but please remember to fully answer the questions.
