Second Year

1st Quarter

<u>Old Testament Book By Book</u> is a General Introduction, not a detailed study of the text. The student will be guided through tying previous Old Testament studies to a book of the Bible. This quarter also teaches the events and major points of each Old Testament book and enables the student to use the Bible to locate Bible answers quickly.

2nd Quarter

New Testament Book By Book is also a General Introduction, instead of a detailed study of the text. As with Old Testament Book By Book, the Bible student is taught how tie previous NewTestament studies to a book of the Bible directing a book by book study of the New Testament in a manner similar to book by book study of Old Testament.

3rd Quarter

The Church will bring to mind the truth of God's plan for man's salvation before the foundation of the Earth was ever lain. Showing the church in prophecy, preparation, and establishment. The Bible student will be guided through God's plans for salvation, worship, organization, church discipline, and the work of the church with emphases on Christian living.

4th Quarter

The Book Of Acts is the gateway, the bridge, showing the connection of the Old Testament to the New Testament. Beginning with the ascension; detailing the establishment of the church, and giving examples of conversion the student is carried through Paul's missionary journey, and ending with his imprisonment.
