Learning Outcomes

100% of the participants reported having learned something in the classes.

71% of participants were able to specifically state what they learned and how it affected their parenting.

39% of participants gave positive responses to the program but did not write specifics on the final evaluation.

Pre-Assessment

65% of participant scored below 50% on the pre-assessment

34% scored between 50-65%

3% scored between 65-72%

Post-Assessment

81% scored 85% or higher on the post-assessment

15% scored between 85% and 75%

4% were encouraged to retake the class

1% actual re-take the class
