John 10:27-30

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Easter, and the Gospel is very short this week! Just like last week, we remember that Jesus is the Good Shepherd, and we are his sheep. A shepherd keeps his sheep healthy by feeding them. Jesus feeds us through His Body and Blood in the Eucharist. In this way, He gives us eternal life. In today's Gospel, when Jesus says that the "Father and I are one," He is saying that He is God. This means that, whenever we receive the Eucharist, we are receiving God. Do you live your life as if God is truly present in the Eucharist? How can you deepen your love of Our Eucharistic Lord?

#### **Activities:**

- Attend a weekday Mass. Receiving Jesus lovingly and worthily is the best way to express our gratitude for His love in the Eucharist. Thank Jesus for all He does for you.
- Pray the Fifth Luminous Mystery of the Rosary: The Institution of the Eucharist. Offer
  the decade up for all those who do not believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the
  Eucharist.
- Make a healthy and delicious meal as a family. As you eat, remind everyone that this is how Jesus feeds us in the Eucharist.




