Ten Commandments Scenarios

One day you go into the store with your best friend, and your friend challenges you to take something without paying, and you take it. . . .

One day you go fishing, and the fishing is really good. You have a great day. Fishing is your favorite thing to do. You think about it all the time. You can still get to the 5 pm Mass, but you decide to stay and fish more and not go to Mass. (

One day at School you and your friends go into a room that is only for teachers and employees. While in the room you knock over a vase and it breaks on the floor. You all run out of the room and one of the teachers sees YOU running away, and no one else. You tell the teacher that you went into the room with your friends, and someone else knocked over the vase, but you didn't see who it was. You tell the teacher the names of everyone who was in the room with you. Everybody who was in the room at the time has to do attention after school, and everybody has to pay to buy a new vase. (

One Sunday morning you wake up and there is a foot of snow on the ground, and no one has come to plow the street you live on. You know that there will be Mass because the priest lives next to the Church, and they have to celebrate Mass no matter what. Your family decides to stay home until your able to get to Church, and you don't go to Mass that day.

Your friend gets a new bicycle, and you ask your parents to buy you a new bicycle too, and they tell you no, and then you become angry with them.

You go to your friend's house for a visit, and there is a bowl of candy in the kitchen, and your friend's mom tells you both that you can't have any candy until after supper. The phone rings, and mom goes into the other room to talk, and while she's in the other room, you and your friend take a piece of candy, and eat it before the mom comes back into the kitchen.

One day you go into the NY City to see a play. Your plan is to go to the play, and then go to the 5 pm Mass later in the day. The traffic on the way home is backed-up for miles because of an accident, and you miss the 5 pm Mass.

Your brother or sister have something that you really like. You wish that you had it. One day, you take it and bring it to school and show it to your friends. Later that day, they notice that it's missing and they become angry and upset and everyone at home is looking for it. In the meantime, you put what you borrowed back in the room without anyone seeing. Eventually, they find what was missing, and everything quiets down at home. The next day, they find out that you had it because somebody at school told them that they liked what you showed them. Everybody is angry with you, and you are angry with them. (7-Steal)

Your parents buy you a new video game, and it's advertised as the best one, and all of your friends have it. It's the first time, and the first week you have a video Game of your own. It's yours, and no one else can play it. Your parents will NOT let you use it in your bedroom, you have to use it in the kitchen or the family room. Everyday, before you go to school, when you get home after school, after dinner, and before you go to bed, you play your new video game. It's all that you can think about. Then, when Sunday morning comes, it's time to go to Mass, but you want to stay home and play your video game instead. You argue with your parents, they make you go to Mass, and you can't play the video game for a week, and you are very angry with your parents.
