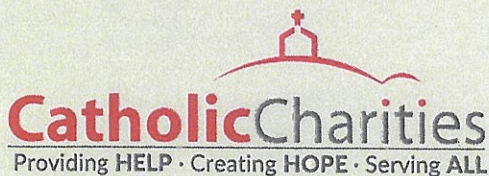

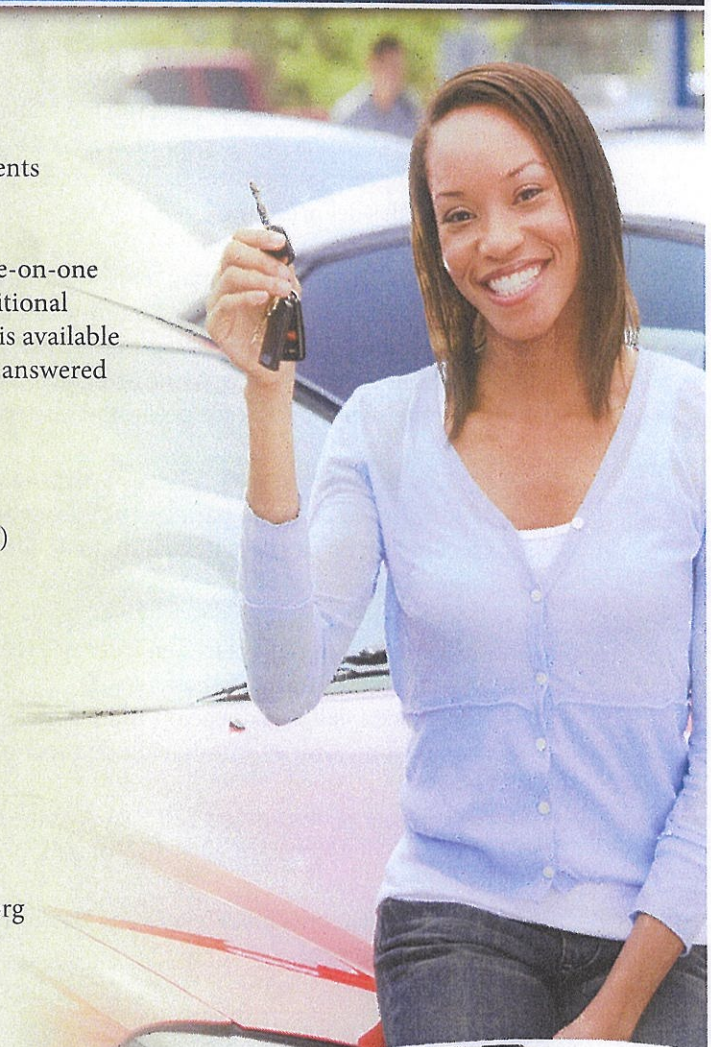

Room To Grow Preschool is a State licensed and Nationally Accredited facility that provides high quality care and education for children ages 3 to 5 years old who reside in Norwalk, Connecticut. Our licensed capacity is 132 children; partially grant funded through a School Readiness grant, which requires that you are a resident of the City of Norwalk. These spots are available on a sliding fee scale based on family income.

Room To Grow offers center based counseling with in the newly opened Family Resource Center; in addition to a fully stock food pantry to help support the needs of the families we serve.


