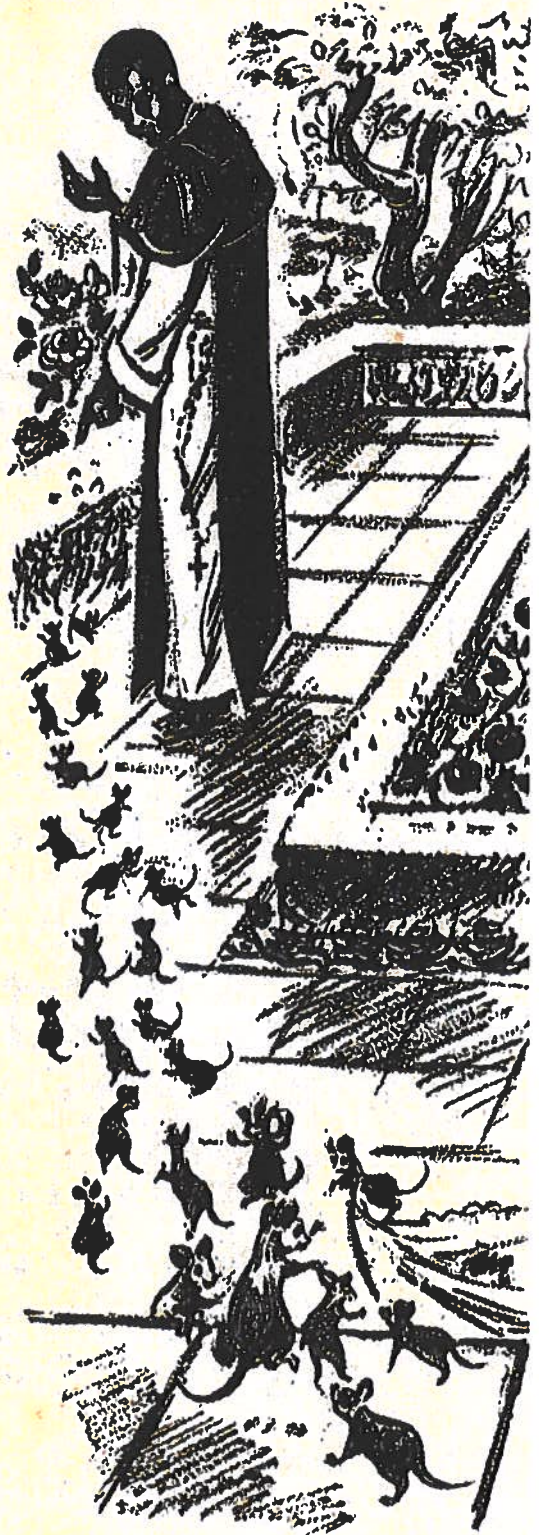




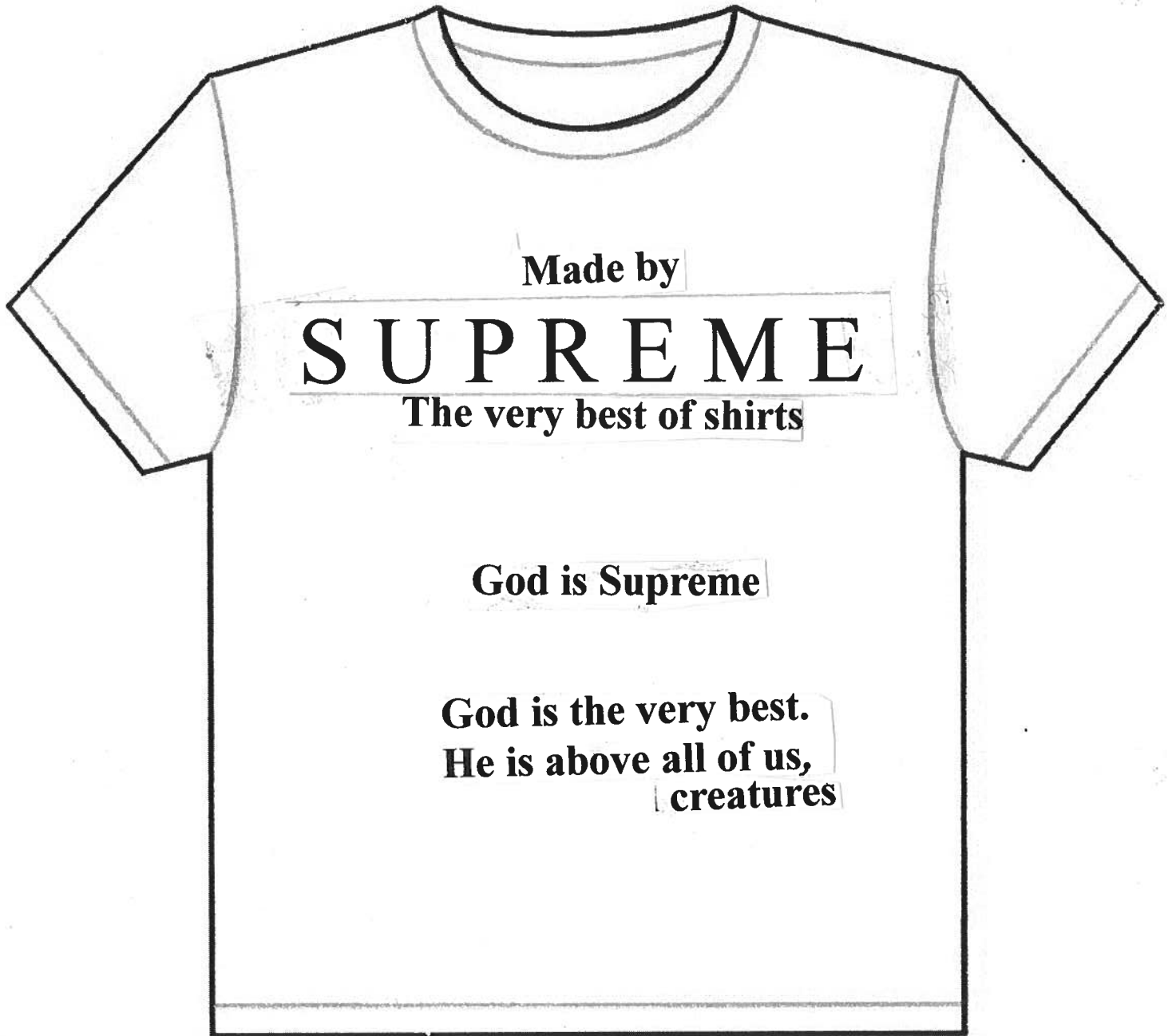
trouble they had caused and how sad it made him. They were acting according to their nature when they did these things, Martin agreed. But that kind of nature was not made for living in a monastery.
