### Diocesan Assessment

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on *all* gross receipts. For our 2021 fiscal year, the annual Cathedratum Assessment is \$89,705. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,869. This represents an annual increase of \$104.00 from the prior year.

### F AST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

Catholics over the age of 14 years are required to abstain from meat every Friday during Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required by Church law to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Only one full meal is permitted to persons in this age group on this day, plus two lighter meals.

## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Thomas Parishioners,

This weekend our Liturgy Of The Word opens with the words of the Prophet Jeremiah. In the Hebrew language the word *nabi*, “spokesperson”, traditionally translates as “prophet”. The meaning of *nabi* is perhaps described best in Deuteronomy 18:18, where God said, “...and I will put My words in his mouth, and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.” Thus, the *nabi* was thought to be the “mouth” of God. The Prophetic Movement of the Old Testament impacts generations of kings, leaders, people and nations. The writings of the Prophets are an integral part of the Bible; beautiful poetry and numerous allegories, oracles and meditations show us a tremendous undertaking of the Agents of God toward people’s salvation. “Turn your hearts back to God” - that phrase sounds almost like a mantra, being really a common denominator in every single prophetic book. One of my favorite Prophets is Jeremiah.

His name in His own language means “Yah Exalts”, and being also called the “Weeping prophet”, Jeremiah was one of the major prophets of the Hebrew Bible. Jeremiah is traditionally credited with authoring the Book of Jeremiah, 1 Kings, 2 Kings and the Book of Lamentations, with the assistance and under the editorship of Baruch ben Neriah, his scribe and disciple. Judaism considers the Book of Jeremiah part of its canon, and regards Jeremiah as the second of the Major Prophets. Our Catholic faith also regards Jeremiah as a prophet and he is quoted very frequently in the New Testament. It has been interpreted that Jeremiah “spiritualized and individualized religion” and insisted upon the primacy of the individual's relationship with God. Maybe then, it will be extremely benefitting for us to get familiar again with the Prophet Jeremiah; we still have a good portion of the Lenten Journey ahead of us, so let us take a moment and open our Bibles to the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah and hear His voice again calling us to repentance and metanoia – fruitful change of heart.






