



Holy Land Bethlehem Artworks December 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>

This organization provides assistance to over 100 suffering families each week. Handmade rosaries, statues, crosses, and nativities are wonderful gifts for family and friends; or an opportunity to add a beautiful hand carved religious item for your home to be cherished through generations. The religious articles are made by the suffering Christian families in the Holy Land, and are their means of spreading the word of Jesus, a goal that began two thousand years ago. The population in the Holy Land has dropped from over 65% to under 1% just within the last ten years. Crafting the religious articles is the primary means for providing for the livelihood of Christian families in the Holy Land.






