

For our 2023 fiscal year, the annual Cathedraticum Assessment is \$81,472. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,567. This represents an annual decrease of \$3,600.00 from the prior year.



#### MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Thomas Parishioners,

First and foremost, please allow me to thank you all for coming to celebrate Easter with us in such great numbers! I know I can also speak for Fr. Ralph here because we share the same gratitude to the Lord Almighty for the great gift of Holy Week and Easter here at Saint Thomas Parish. All the preparations and behind the scenes arrangements are very important for everything to be presented and received well, but the essence of the greatest annual Catholic Celebration, that is, the Paschal Mystery of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection, is realized in our hearts as we pray together and offer the Most Holy Eucharist these days. Therefore, once again, to all of you – a sincere Thank you!

One of the most moving episodes related to Easter Sunday is the story of the disciples of Christ on the way to Emmaus. Many paintings, sculptures, and meditations were done on that Gospel scene. On the road to Emmaus, one can get lost, not because it is somehow a very long or difficult distance because, as the Gospel according to St. Luke tells us, that pair of Disciples were able to cover the round trip in one day. It is easy for one to get lost on the road to Emmaus for the very reasons the Disciples mentioned in today's Gospel got lost and so sad. Even today, maybe more than ever, surrounded by the loud mass confusion, we can get lost navigating through life. That is true especially when we are losing our sight of Jesus. Every time I pray or meditate on this particular excerpt of Luke's Gospel, I am in awe of how our Lord finds me whenever I am lost; almost like that stranger joining the Disciples as they run from Jerusalem to Emmaus. Our Good Lord touches my heart and spirit with total strangers at times to remind me that He is Risen! He does so to always encourage me to see Him even in total strangers; imagine if we could pray today at our own Emmaus here in East Norwalk, at our own Liturgy of the Breaking of Bread, that the Risen Lord strengthens us as He did His Disciples in Emmaus so we too may run to the people we love and even to those we don't know and, overwhelmed with joy, say to them – the Lord has Risen!




