

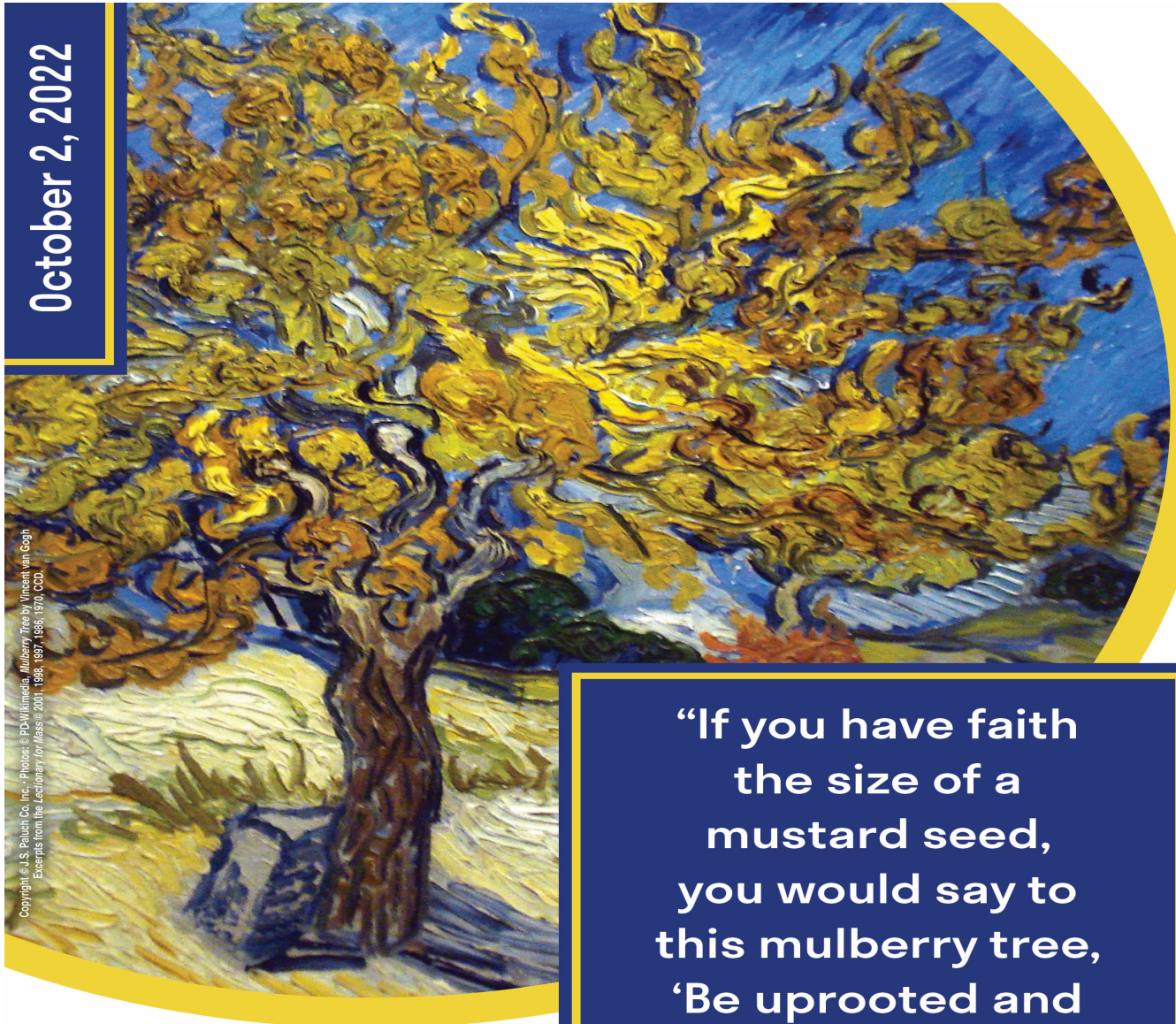

Diocesan Assessment

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on all gross receipts. For our 2023 fiscal year, the annual Cathedralium Assessment is \$81,472. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,567. This represents an annual decrease of \$3,600.00 from the prior year.

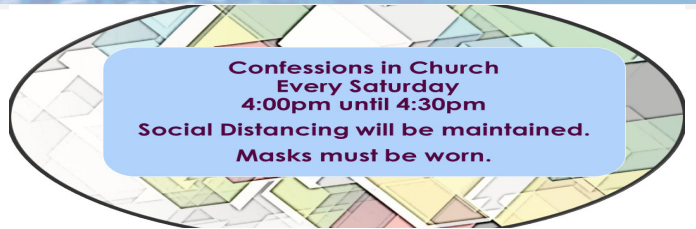

REFLECTION FROM FR. RALPH

Now that we have all come back from the Summer Break, I think it pretty obvious that things have ramped up a bit. Academics for this year have resumed in the public and private schools, as well as our Religious Education program here at St. Thomas Parish. Our work schedule, commuting, personal errands, the change in weather, and even now, any plans for the Holidays which loom large in the back of our minds, have brought about a difference in regard to schedules, calendars and appointments.

The demand is greater, the efforts necessary to meet what is before us has increased, and we need to keep up with all that whirs around us, or we will fall behind. All of this brings about the need to do what we must do, so as to not disappoint those who depend on us. But we'll get it done. We always do. It requires a response that is both necessary and immediate. It's a call to action. We always seem, in the end to muster what is necessary so that we can even say to a mulberry tree: "*be uprooted and planted in the sea* (Lk 17:6)."

To be sure, we need faith if we are to meet all that is before us this time of the year, or at least, we should. Perhaps we can slip into a mentality that faith is only for Church, or when struck with a difficult trial or tragedy. It is essential that we always strive to make a connection with our way of life and our discipleship in Jesus Christ in all that we do. With this, we'll always be able to see the deeper meaning and purpose of our lives.

Something else for us to keep mind is that, just as we do what we need to do in our work, personal errands, for our families, as well as civic duties, we need to do the said same in regard to the practice of our faith. Going to Mass, confession, Religious Education, making time for prayer, and of course, works of charity in the name of Jesus Christ are just as necessary as the many tasks that are unexpectedly thrust upon us or assigned to us at our own doing, so that we can negotiate what many consider the busiest season of the year.

Perhaps what we hear in the Gospel this week can turn us off. Jesus tells us: *when you have done all you have been commanded, say, we are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do* (Lk 17:10)." Now, it's not that what we do from day to day is insignificant in reference to our religious faith; and it's not that, whether religious or domestic, we'll never be able to please God; it's just that Jesus wants us to remember in all we may do, if in His name, is not only necessary, but what God intends for us. We must not allow pride, the exclusive motivation of personal success, or even worse, neglecting or ignoring the influence of God in our lives altogether to prevail over us. So, may we always keep in mind what St. Polycarp teaches us regarding our relationship with God: "*If we please him in this life, we shall receive the life to come; for he has promised us that he will raise us from the dead, and that, if we lead lives worthy of him, we shall reign along with him. This is what our faith tells us.*"
