

NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC RENEWAL

As I mentioned this past weekend, we have the opportunity to participate in the National Eucharistic Revival which will be observed in our Diocese May 19th through May 22nd. The potential for us as a Parish community to experience a fresh or reinvigorated devotion to Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament which we receive at every Mass is both necessary and great.

This event is a very unique occurrence in our Diocese, and I encourage any and every parishioner to participate in at least one event in our immediate area, inclusive of Westport, Norwalk and Darien.

Now, I realize that more proximate events do in fact fall during the weekdays, and your personal schedules makes participation challenging. So, there are handouts which will be available at the entrances of the Church until Wednesday that detail the events and opportunities that are taking place while the Blessed Sacrament passes through the Diocese of Bridgeport. 
