### Diocesan Assessment

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on all gross receipts. For our 2022 fiscal year, the annual Cathedralricum Assessment is \$85,072. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,636. This represents an annual decrease of \$4,633.00 from the prior year.

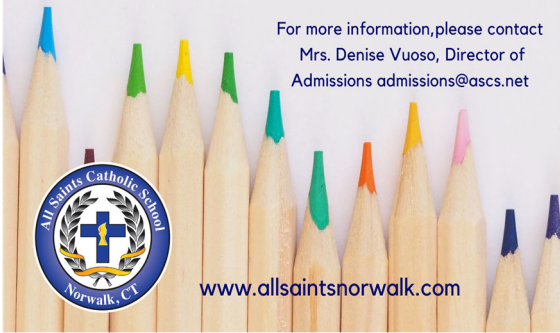

## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Thomas the Apostle Parishioners,

Many of us can easily identify with today's Gospel lesson. Please, think for a moment and try to recall the times you have been told the same as Jesus was in today's Gospel according to Saint Luke: "Physician, cure yourself"? I know it happened to me on many occasions and I still remember each and every single one. Why? Because of something I have done and said, that provoked such a reaction, and in 99% of circumstances I have provoked such feedback in a way that people responded back to me with: "Who do you think you are to tell me this?" or "Well, look at yourself first." or "How dare you to say that to me..." – My Friends, in all these events I was simply quoting or paraphrasing the words of Jesus, Christ and Lord. And that's what amazes me every day, why our Lord's Words provoke such feedback? Why the sayings of Jesus very often make people uncomfortable or even angry? In other words, you recall all the many events from the pages of the Gospels, when Jesus was confronted by both, most religious, zealous, holier than thou on one hand, and very liberal in their thinking and religious practices on the other? And in almost all of the events, both parties, while in their day to day gray life, really hated each other, were like arch enemies to one another, like water and fire, after the confrontation with Jesus they would shake hands very quickly, and conspire of how to kill Him, rather than to listen to Him any longer, forget believing that he is the Christ, The Holy One of God. Why is that? What is so strange, or powerful or maybe dangerous about that Jesus, that even 2000 years later He makes many people uncomfortable? Well, in my humble opinion, based on the experience I was given through 19 years of priestly ministry, and more that 30 years of study of Sacred Scripture and Catholicism, the reason Jesus' words provoke such reactions in people, is that He is the epitome of Truth. Christ calls Himself the Truth. Not one of many different truths, opinions, points of view to have, ways to follow; no! Christ Jesus says it very clearly: "I am the Truth" or "I am the Way". And it is so appealing to me because I see that the OBJECTIVE TRUTH is in crisis today – more than ever – and I think we should all do something about it.

After all, my friends, one of the primary advantages of being a person of faith, more specifically the Catholic faith, is the ability to live a balanced and hopeful life between our past and the future. For us Catholics who are serious about our faith, Jesus Christ moves from being a subject of historical debate or a glorious plan for the future, to a living reality – that is when we discover Him in the present – here and now.
