→AST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. Catholics over the age of 14 years are required to abstain from meat every Friday during Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required by Church law to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Only one full meal is permitted to persons in this age group on this day, plus two lighter meals.



The 2026 MASS BOOK will open on Thursday, March 13th, *from 10am until 1pm.* Only 2 Saturday Vigil or Sunday weekend masses may be booked and no more than 4 Sanctuary Candles until April 30th. *Please come to the front door of the Rectory. No phone or email requests until Friday, March 14th.*


