

#### **Diocesan Assessment**

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on <u>all</u> gross receipts. For our 2023 fiscal year, the annual Cathedraticum Assessment is \$81,472. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,567. This represents an annual decrease of \$3,600.00 from the prior year.

# REFLECTION FROM FR. RALPH

One of the basic issues that we deal with as disciples of Jesus Christ is what we should do to fulfill God's will in our lives. Now, as you know, this is not always so easy and simple, but we are in fact called to respond to God's will; and if we do, that is, at least respond, we can be confident that God knows our good intentions, and God will always, on His part, respond in such a way and degree that we can continue on our journey of faith, producing good fruit.

We can see in the first reading of the Book of Wisdom that God established, through human cooperation, the tradition, the worship, and the way of life of the Israelite people (this can be found in numerous places in the Bible). In the second reading in the Letter to the Hebrews we read that regarding Abraham, our father in faith, God fulfilled the promises He made to Abraham; and in the Gospel, Jesus calls us to anticipate the blessing of the resurrection through a preparatory way of life that nurtures a disposition of heart so that the grace of God can work in us, making it possible for us to enter into the glory of God.

What we have considered thus far leads to questions concerned with what God can do, what God does, and what we can do so that we can grow in God's grace as we make the journey of faith. Now we know that through the incarnation in the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary, through the power and working of the Holy Spirit, Jesus became like us in all things but sin. Subsequent to this, God the Father accomplished and fulfilled all that He intended from before the foundation of the world in and through the person of Jesus Christ. But there's something more. St. Athanasius tells us: "for the Son of God became man so that we might become God," meaning, that in and through Jesus Christ, not only did God render the means of salvation for the entire human family, not only did He establish the said means of salvation regarding the created order as we know it, God prepared all that God has within us. In short, through the incarnation in which Jesus became like us in all things but sin, there is a commensurability regarding the human and divine that did not exist before.

It is then for us to cooperate, or perhaps even better, enter into what God has given us so that what is possible for us can become a reality. I say "enter into" because what is available to us is already prepared and made ready for us; its just a matter of us being willing to involve ourselves in the Great Plan of Salvation. So, it is for us to respond when called, just as Jesus teaches us in today's Gospel: "Gird your loins and light your lamps and be like servants who await their master's return from a wedding, ready to open immediately when he comes and knocks. Blessed are those servants whom the master finds vigilant on his arrival. Amen, I say to you, he will gird himself, have them recline at table, and proceed to wait on them. And should he come in the second or third watch and find them prepared in this way, blessed are those servants (Lk 12: 35-38)."

Notice that Jesus tells us that the master will "wait on" us, serve us, provide us with whatever we need. We should honestly be able to admit that God has done everything that God can possible do up to this point, and it is God who has done it! What is important here is that this is not exclusive to the many issues we face in our world today; that's where we come into the picture, so to speak. Rather, this is in regard to who we are, what we are, and who we can and will be as we continue to allow God to render in us what He wills. As St. Paul tells us: "at present we see indistinctly, as in a mirror, but then face to face. At present I know partially; then I shall know fully, as I am fully known (1 Cor 13:12)." What St. Paul means is that one day, with the gift of faith and God's grace, if we cooperate with what God provides, we will be fully known to God, we will fully know God, because we will be fully present to God just as He intended from the beginning.

So, may we continue on our way, lending ourselves to the means God has provided, confident that we need to do is meant for us, each one of us, keeping in mind what we read in the Letter to the Hebrews: "Now they desire a better homeland, a heavenly one. Therefore, God is not ashamed to be called their God, for he has prepared a city for them (Heb 11:16)."






