

#### **Diocesan Assessment**

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on <u>all</u> gross receipts. For our 2024 fiscal year, the annual Cathedraticum Assessment is \$78,324. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,506. This represents an annual decrease of \$3,148.00 from the prior year.

## REFLECTION FROM FR. RALPH

As we have discussed in the past, both at Mass and in the Parish Bulletin, throughout Old Testament revelation, we see God working great signs and wonders through creation and the elements of nature. Overtime, God gradually communicated more subtly through chosen representatives of His words and will, especially after the Babylonian conquest of Israel in 597 bc, followed by the deportations of the Israelite people beginning in 587 bc.


The first reading from the first Book of Kings is a sign, if you will, that Elijah's call by God was something that could not be heard through the powerful movements of nature. Rather, he heard God through "a tiny whispering sound." It is still true, and this is classic Catholic Theology, that creation is an obligatory reference for us, that there is a God who created all things, and that we can begin to know God through what God has created. St. Paul tells us in his letter to the Romans: "Ever since the creation of the world, his invisible attributes of eternal power and divinity have been able to be understood and perceived in what he has made (Rom 1:20)."

In the Gospel for this weekend, Jesus walks on water. Perhaps what at first can be a matter of focus, is the wind and the water violently expressing God's power and divinity who made and has authority over all of creation. Yet now, it is Jesus Christ Himself who is given, if you will, the said same power and authority, and, in spite of great disturbance, unpredictability, and yes, even great danger, Jesus will calm our hearts, minds, and souls. St. Peter was eager to make his way to Jesus under very difficult and unpredictable circumstances, and he was distracted and became fearful. It was enough to cause St. Peter to become overwhelmed and he began to sink. But Jesus reached out and lifted him up, leading him to safety and calm.

I do not intend in any way to make light of the challenges, difficulties, and most especially, the unpredictable, sudden, and devastating events that take place in our lives. But we can be confident, as difficult as it can be to recognize God's presence in our lives at such moments, Jesus Christ Our Lord is always with us throughout the misfortune we experience in our lives, even in regard to things that result from bad decisions or sinful conduct. May we always remember that, no matter how and for whatever reason we experience that which can disturb our lives, our hearts, our minds, and our souls, Jesus will always say to us most gently and compassionately: "Take courage, it is I, do not be afraid (Mt 14:27)."


