Diocesan Assessment

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on <u>all</u> gross receipts. For our 2023 fiscal year, the annual Cathedraticum Assessment is \$81,472. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,567. This represents an annual decrease of \$3,600.00 from the prior year.

→AST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. Catholics over the age of 14 years are required to abstain from meat every Friday during Lent. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required by Church law to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Only one full meal is permitted to persons in this age group on this day, plus two lighter meals.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR


Dear St. Thomas the Apostle Parishioners,

O LORD, our Lord(...). What is man that you are mindful of him, and a son of man that you care for him? Yet you have made him little less than a god, crowned him with glory and honor. See Psalm 8.

On Ash Wednesday, so many of you came to mark the Lenten Journey for this year, and I am very thankful to all of you, my friends, for your renewed commitment to Christ Jesus. Imposition of the ashes made from burned palms from the last Palm Sunday, not only keeps us humble and serves as a powerful symbol of our penitence, but also helps us to look deeper into our hearts and present before Our Lord all that needs to be healed in our lives. In today's Liturgy of the Word, Jesus reveals His glory to His closest friends and, I think, by analogy, to you and me on the very site where the final Parousia (Second Coming) and the Final Judgment will take place, according to traditional beliefs.

Isn't it remarkable? Now, so many hundreds of years after the actual event has taken place, Jesus still reminds us, in this precious time of Lent, that we, too, will have many battles between good and evil in our lives.
