3rd Sunday of Easter

John 21:1-19

Today is the Third Sunday of Easter! We continue to hear about Jesus appearing to His disciples after His death and resurrection. In this Gospel, some disciples have been out all night fishing with no success. A man from the shore instructs them where to lower their nets and immediately they have a large catch! They realize that it is HIM, JESUS! They even eat breakfast with Him.

Then, something even more special happens. Jesus gives Peter three opportunities to acknowledge his love for Jesus. This is because Peter had denied knowing Jesus three times at His Passion. Here, Jesus forgives Peter and gives him the care of His Church, telling Peter to feed the sheep and lambs which belong to Jesus (that's us!).

Activities:

- Even though stores have put away their Easter bunnies and baskets, the Church is still fully in Easter Season (and will be for another month!). How can you live out the Easter Season in your home this week?
- Learn about shepherds, they put a lot of care and effort into their sheep! Then discuss how this shows God's love for us, since Jesus is the Good Shepherd.
- Christ forgave Peter today and gave him the opportunity to mend the hurt which had been caused by Peter's denial. Is there someone you need to forgive or a hurt which you need to mend?
