### Diocesan Assessment

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on all gross receipts. For our 2022 fiscal year, the annual Cathedraticum Assessment is \$85,072. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,636. This represents an annual decrease of \$4,633.00 from the prior year.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Thomas the Apostle Parishioners,

I wonder how many of you had a chance (more so the will or a desire) to attempt opening the Encyclical Letter *Dominum et Vivificantem*, as in English translates to “The Lord and The Giver of Life” (1986) by Saint John Paul II? We have talked briefly of how well our Sainly Pope finishes His trilogy of Trinitarian Cateches presented in his Letters *Redemptor Hominis* – “Redeemer of Man” (1979) and the 1980 Letter *Dives in misericordia* “Rich in Mercy”. We have mentioned how much more today’s Modern World needs to hear John Paul II’s words, full of hope and encouragement. If you have read the *Dominum et Vivificantem* Encyclical, you could not possibly miss the profound numbers 58 and 59 of the text, where John Paul II speaks about an “ Inner-Man” and how, as he calls it, the Inner Maturity, anchored in Truth, of how “*Man's intimate relationship with God in the Holy Spirit also enables him to understand himself, his own humanity, in a new way. Thus, that image and likeness of God which man is from his very beginning is fully realized.*” (59).

Maybe some time in the future we could do a nice Pasta and Vino dinner and remind ourselves of these Letters and discuss how we could use the advice given by John Paul II today? You let me know.

Today’s celebration, the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, reminds us that we belong to the fullness of God. The readings each give a glance at one of the Persons of the Trinity. Even if we have studied the volumes and volumes of books that have been written on the mystery of the Trinity, chances are we would end up in the very place we have begun our study. It is over all a mystery of our faith; The heart of that mystery is simply that God dwells within us.
