**Diocesan Assessment**

The assessment is used to cover the cost of Diocesan operations and schools. The formula is based on all gross receipts. For our 2023 fiscal year, the annual Cathedralium Assessment is \$81,472. This equates to a weekly payment of \$1,567. This represents an annual decrease of \$3,600.00 from the prior year.

Dear St. Thomas Parishioners,

A very clear symbol of John, Jesus' own cousin, who history calls The Baptist, can help us to navigate thru the Advent season again this year, especially with the testimony of Jesus about John the Baptist: What did you come to see? Maybe in a sense this passage gives us a much deeper clue about the meaning of the Advent Season? Perhaps the simple symbol of candles lit each Advent weekend shows us that we all need that Light; in a figurative and in a very real sense, to get thru the gloomy and gray, short days and long evenings, of December, to gain some extra strength, especially for the moments when we "don't feel like doing anything" or simply put: we need that Light of Jesus so we don't get lost navigating thru the Pre – Christmas Extravaganza. As we have mentioned throughout the liturgies of last weekend, Advent is given to us each year for a reason. In my humble opinion, the Season of Advent, as it exists in XXI century, could help us to better understand the meaning of a joyful, expectant vigil. More so now than ever, we, as the followers of Jesus, need to re – evaluate the meaning and importance of patience, perseverance, waiting, and quiet anticipation.
