

25th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Luke 16:1-13

In Luke's Gospel reading for today, Jesus told His disciples a parable about a dishonest steward. The steward's master decided to fire him because he had not taken good care of his master's property. The steward tried to protect himself, so that when his employment ended, he would have people to help him. Jesus taught his disciples: "No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon."

This means that we must decide who we want to serve in this life—God or the world? Choosing to serve God means that we will face challenges, choices, and sacrifices. But God's love for us and the promises He gives us will sustain us always! And even if it seems harder in the moment, it is always easier in the long run!

Activities:

- We show someone that we love them by talking to them or spending time with them. This week, find time to sit quietly and be with God!
- Jesus says in this Gospel, "The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones." What do you think He means by this? Can you think of an example from your own life of what this means?
- Think of a time in your life when you chose to do the right thing even though it was harder in the moment. Did you notice afterwards that you were grateful for doing it?




