2022 Impact Report

The mission of the Van Buren Center is to support and strengthen the community by compassionately addressing the needs of men, women, and families experiencing a homeless crisis by providing a safe and healthy environment where everyone is treated with dignity, compassion, and respect.

In 2022 Van Buren Center provided emergency shelter to **4,775 individuals** in central Ohio. **223,662 meals** were prepared and served from our Caring Kitchen through the incredible partnership and support from the Mid Ohio Food Collective.

It is because of the incredible support and efforts of our staff, board members, volunteers, and community partners that the YMCA Van Buren Center continues to play a critical role in ending and preventing homelessness in Franklin County. Programming highlights for 2022 include increasing our volunteer hours and volunteer participation by 30% and expanding our available workshops and resources for our guests with the launch of the Knowledge Center on the Family Side. Raising \$200,000 for our Give Her Hope Campaign where 100% of the funds go directly to our guests.

Besa + Van Buren Annual Valentine's Dinner


For the last 5 years, **Besa** has partnered with and sponsored an annual Valentine's Dinner for Van Buren Shelter.

On Super Bowl Sunday, members from the foundation volunteered to serve dinner and then brought **200 love bags** for the women at Van Buren.




