This year marked the 4th anniversary of Van Buren Center's Holiday Workshop. Together with the help of volunteers our Holiday Workshop happened with added measures to keep everyone safe and socially distanced, while still creating a space and event that let our families know how important and special, they are.



52 families participated in the <u>Holiday</u> <u>Workshop</u> this year and **93 children** received a joyful holiday season. Volunteers, or "elves" as we like to call them, helped parents pick out 6 new toys, a stuffed animal, blanket, unlimited books, and clothing for their children and then wrapped the gifts. The parents also received their own gift, as well as our single adult men and women.

We had a family who previously was a guest in our Van Buren Family shelter and participated in our Holiday Workshop return, but this year as a donor. They have been successfully housed since their stay at Van Buren Center but have not forgotten about what a special and meaningful experience the Holiday Workshop was for them. The mother of the family explained it was her son that asked if they could donate toys because he remembered how much it meant to him to receive



gifts while they were in shelter.
