Maximizing Accessibility To Housing: James' Story

When James moved into the YMCA's



Permanent Supportive Housing program in December 2022, he was rebuilding his life after cancer left him weighing just 88 pounds. At the Y, he found more than shelter — he found a supportive community.

"The guys here helped me when I was down," James said. "They made sure I ate, got out of bed, kept my clothes washed. That meant a lot."

After living at the Y's temporary housing site, James became one of the first residents at **McKinley Manor**, a newly built supportive housing complex. Surrounded by sunlight, houseplants, and his favorite sports memorabilia, James began to thrive — not just as a

tenant, but as a leader.

He joined the **Resident Advisory Board**, a group of residents who meet monthly with YMCA staff to improve life and foster connection at McKinley Manor. He's even hosted a community cookout for his 66th birthday, personally funding the event and bringing in his son to give free haircuts.


"I want it to feel like family," he said.

James is now working with his case manager, Miss Jessica, toward his next goal: a home big enough for all his grandkids. But no matter where life takes him, he knows one thing for sure:

"This place saved my life. I'm grateful every single morning I wake up."

Columbus REALTORS Brings Compassion and Hard Work to Life on Annual Care Day 2025



On a day filled with teamwork, generosity, and purpose, more than 170 volunteers from Columbus REALTORS came

Throughout the day, volunteers rolled up their sleeves and tackled an ambitious list of improvements and contributions. They revitalized our community garden by weeding, mulching, and rebuilding garden beds. A brand-new shed was

constructed on-site to provide much-needed storage for garden tools, ensuring our green spaces remain sustainable and well-maintained for the long term.

The playground also got a makeover, with volunteers completing a fresh coat of paint on the playground fence and applying new mulch to make the area safer and more inviting for children.

Inside the shelter, the energy and care continued. Volunteers assembled **111 Welcome Home Baskets**, which are given to individuals and families who successfully secure permanent housing, offering them a warm, supportive start in their new homes. Additionally, they put together **100 Snack Bag** kits to provide quick and accessible nourishment for those in need.

Other essential tasks included organizing donated clothing, preparing diaper and wipe kits for families, portioning shampoo and conditioner into individual containers, and assisting in our kitchen to help prepare meals for residents.

Throughout the day, volunteers also had the opportunity to take guided tours of the shelter. These tours gave them a deeper understanding of the wide range of services and support we offer—from case management and employment services to meals, youth programming, and on-site medical care and referrals. It was a powerful way for volunteers to connect their service with the lived experiences of the individuals and families we serve.

Each project, no matter how big or small, was completed with a sense of purpose and unity. Columbus REALTORS demonstrated not only their commitment to our community but also the power of what can be accomplished when people come together with hearts ready to serve.

We are deeply grateful for their time, energy, and dedication, and we look forward to welcoming them back next year!


