

We are so excited that this is the 6th annual **Santa's Workshop** for the families at Van Buren. We have over 100 families currently in our shelter. Our mission is to provide each child with a magical experience this holiday by giving them a reason to smile and feel joy.

What is Santa's Workshop?

Back in 2017, the Van Buren Center saw a need and gap in available opportunities for our families with our holiday giving. To make certain that the children get to receive special gifts picked out specifically with them in mind and given to them by their parents we created **Santa's Workshop**.

Each year, a room in the shelter is transformed into a Winter Wonderland "store" where everything is free. The workshop runs typically the week before Christmas. Parents sign up for a 30-minute appointment slot and with the help of our "elves" (volunteers) they pick out toys, blankets, winter apparel, and so much more for each of their children. The "elves" wrap each gift and then all the wrapped gifts are hidden and bagged up for the parent to take and give to their children.

The experience of **Santa's Workshop** allows the parent to be involved in the magic of the holiday season. It gives them the gift of empowerment and hope.
