# Monthly Case Manager Training with Partner Agencies

These sessions provide valuable information and support to case managers and cover a range of topics related to the services and resources each agency provides. The aim is to help case managers better support guests at Van Buren.

So far, several agencies have participated in this monthly series, including Action for Children- Father Up, Huckleberry House, Columbus Works, Celebrate One, Ohio Means Jobs Veterans Department, Molina Healthcare, RI International- Franklin County Behavioral Health Crisis Care Center, and Cross Point Pharmacy.


