The Van Buren Center values our partnerships with staffing companies and businesses like A Plus Staffing for their collaboration and support to offer employment opportunities to our guests. We are always looking for new businesses to partner with and agencies interested in connecting our guests with valuable resources and support so that they can resolve their housing crisis and get set up for success. Outcomes from July's hiring event include

20 guests attended and learned about available opportunities
11 guests applied and interviewed onsite during the event

Can you secure employment without an ID?

An ID plays a significant role in the hiring process and also in the application process for apartments and rental units. For many of our guests at Van Buren, they enter our doors without any identification including ID, social security card, or birth certificate. Without these essential items, they cannot secure employment or housing. YMCA Van Buren's annual fundraising campaign **Give Hope** provides guests in our shelter with the funds they need to resolve their housing crisis, whether that be a voucher to obtain a new ID or assistance with the first month's rent for their new home. 100% of the funds raised from **Give Hope** go directly to our guests.

Van Buren Center provided safe shelter to 801 individuals in June.



PROGRAM OUTCOMES

- 46** Workshops available onsite to guests in June. - 11 more workshops from last month. 
- 300+** Guests participated and attended a workshop and 113 hours of direct service offered. 
- 18,549** Meals served in June at Van Buren Center. +767 meals from last month. 
- 126** Volunteers gave their time to make a difference and totaled 1,284 hours!
